I he Amplified Bible says, ...I will do marvels (wonders. miracles) such as have not been wrought or created in all the earth or in any nation. The Scripture also implies that those who observe these wonders and marvels will be filled with awe, an overwhelming sense of admiration and reverence. If at some point that covenant had ended and been done away with, then the world would not have seen any more marvels. But there were marvels in the New Testament. When Jesus ministered to individuals, bringing healing and deliverance, people marveled at what He'd done.

God's covenant of doing marvels has never ended. He has always done things that have filled people with awe, admiration, and reverence; however, He's about to turn up the volume. To reach the world in which we now live, the preaching of the gospel will need to be accompanied by signs, wonders, miracles, and marvels that will demonstrate the fact that our God is God!

The prophet Joel said, Fear not, O land; be glad and rejoice: for the Lord will do great things (Joel 2:21 KJV). When God performed wonders on the day of Pentecost, Peter spoke to the crowds in Jerusalem and said, "But this is what was spoken by the prophet Joel" (Acts 2:16).

I'll never forget the time, early in my ministry, when our eighteen-month-old daughter Terri's fingertips were accidentally severed in the church nursery while Brother Copeland was preaching in our church. He prayed for Terri, and then we took her to one of the best surgeons in the

country, who did a skin graft and told us that was all that could be done from a medical standpoint. He said Terri's hand would be forever disfigured. Carolyn and I refused to accept what he said, and we began to declare that God would restore our daughter's fingers.

A few weeks later we took Terri back to the doctor, who was a Buddhist, to remove the dressing. When he cut away the bandages he said, "My God! Her fingers are back; her nails are

back. This is a miracle!" I said,

"No, sir, not your God—my God did this!" As a result of the wonder God performed, that doctor later became a Christian.

The God of Surprises

One of my favorite verses describing God is found in the book of Job: Who does great things, and unsearchable, marvelous things without number (Job 5:9). The Message translation says, After all, he's famous for great and unexpected acts; there's no end to his surprises.

We see one such surprise described in the story of Jesus ministering and teaching to some five thousand families. At the end of the day, when the disciples suggested they go into town to get

food, Jesus told them to have the people to sit down, and then He said, "You feed them." The disciples had only five loaves of bread and two fish, but when Jesus took the food and blessed it, it began to multiply as it was handed out. Everyone ate until they were full, and there were twelve baskets left over. Don't you just know God was saying, "Surprise!" to the people that day?

Something similar to this happened in our ministry when our international director, Joe Mc-Croskey, was feeding the poor in Tanzania. Joe and the team thought they had plenty of food, but they were not prepared for the number of people who came from the surrounding villages in search of a meal that day. Joe led the team in prayer, saying, "Jesus, you multiplied the food before; we ask that you do it again!" The team continued to serve the people until everyone had been fed. They even had food left over—just as the disciples did.

Don't Limit God

Jesus is not a retired preacher and miracle worker; He is still alive and very much in business. However, we are the ones who can limit His marvels, wonders, and extraordinary manifestations when we hold onto thoughts such as *I've never seen Him do anything like that*. Just because one person has never seen Him feed five thousand people doesn't mean He can't do it. There are plenty of things we've not seen God do, but it doesn't mean He can't.

I believe we are headed for a display of God's power like we've never experienced in our lives. The New Testament apostle Paul quoted Old Testament prophet Isaiah when he said, Eye has not seen, nor ear heard, nor have entered into the heart of man the things which God has prepared for those who love Him (1 Corinthians 2:9). What's the purpose of God preparing these things if He's not going to manifest them? Why would God prepare something for those who love Him, and then not let them experience the promise?

Have you ever had someone tell you something that builds up your hope, but then what was promised didn't come through? This may be the way man operates, but it's not the way God operates. If God says He has prepared things for those of us who love Him—things so wonderful that our hearts have not conceived them—then those things are on the way. I plan to be a recipient of every marvel, wonder, miracle, and surprise that God has planned for me.

Faith under Pressure

The Bible says, My brethren, count it all joy when you fall into various trials, knowing that the testing of your faith produces patience. But let patience have its perfect work, that you may be perfect and complete, lacking nothing (James 1:2). The Message translation says, Consider it a sheer gift, friends, when tests and challenges come at you from all sides. You know that under pressure, your faith-life is forced into the open and shows its true colors.

In other words, God says, "Don't give up just because you're under pressure. That's when I'm most likely to bring a surprise. That's when I'm most

likely to turn what Satan meant for bad into something good."

The Word of God says, Now thanks be to God who always leads us in triumph in Christ... (2 Corinthians 2:14). When we go through a trial, all we see is the trial—but God sees us in the process of being triumphant. Don't ever give up on God; He is the wonder-worker, the God of surprises. Stay in faith.

John said, Now this is the confi-

dence that we have in Him, that if we ask anything according to His will, He hears us. And if we know that He hears us, whatever we ask, we know that we have the petitions that we have asked of Him (1 John 5:14–15). The Lord instructed me to write a prayer of petition, which was inspired by the Holy Spirit. I invite you to take this prayer and make it your own as you stand in faith to see God's marvels, wonders, and extraordinary manifestations in your own life.

Heavenly Father, in the name of Jesus, You are the God of the breakthrough; You are the God of the turn around. You take what the devil means for bad, and You turn it into something good. You are good, and the source of good.

Your Word declares that no weapon formed against me shall prosper, and that triumph over opposition is the heritage of the servants of the Lord. You're the God who preserves and the God who vindicates the faithful. You're the God who leads us into victory in every transition and in every changing season of our lives. You are the God who teaches us to profit, the God who restores everything Satan has stolen from us.

We have nothing to fear because You are for us, and You are by our side. And if our God be for us, then no one can successfully be our enemy. You will not abandon us in our trouble, and You will not allow the adversary to prevail over us. Your goodness awaits us, and we wait on You; we will not wayer.

We now thank you in advance because we know that our God reigns and our God will not allow us to fail. In Jesus' name we expect Your goodness, and we rejoice in Your loving kindness. *Amen.*



Dr. Savelle and I literally traveled this past year into all the world like Jesus commanded in Mark 16! God was so faithful to show up and show out just like He said He would, manifesting His presence, His goodness and His glory.

Holy Spirit took over and showed Dr. Savelle 11 African nations that his ministry was to take the Gospel to: Botswana, Democratic Republic of Congo (former Zaire), Ethiopia, Ghana, Kenya, Nigeria, South Africa, Tanzania, Uganda,

Right before our eyes, He was fulfilling the prophecy He gave to Dr. Savelle for 2018. Unusual supernatural church meetings took place twice in Italy, then in Hawaii and Witbank, South Africa. We also had the privilege of starting Bible Schools all over the world: the Philippines, Wales, Ireland, Ethiopia, Kenya, Arizona and even Cuba! Whether we ministered in a meeting, a conference, seeded our materials or started a Bible School, we were fulfilling God's mandate given to Dr. Savelle! Take the Gospel of Jesus Christ and make all people into disciples of Jesus making them winners in life! Jesus said, "If you abide in My word [hold fast to My teachings and live in accordance with them], you are truly My disciples," John 8:31 AMP. We can testify that if anyone, not just a minister, but anyone hears and acts on the Word of God, it will not only change that person's life, but that life can change the world for God.

My calling at JSMI is doing mission work in the US and all over the world, as the International Director. Thirty years ago in a small hotel room in Kenya, Dr. Savelle called me and our team to expound on training disciples for God. During that meeting the Zambia and Zimbabwe. We have endeavored to do this ever since.

Originally, our headquarters were in Kenya as well as South Africa. We then moved our Kenyan headquarters to Tanzania. We continued to work, however, with the ministry we left to take over in Kenya. South Africa and Tanzania have been major centers where we use our Bible School to train ministers and pastors from all over Africa. The mandate in all the African nations has been fulfilled except for three. Then last year the Lord took our discipleship training to another level as we followed 'Oral Roberts' motto "make no little plans here". Since Kenya was one of the nations in the mandate, this past year we began a Bible School with a class of 24 pastors and are working alongside Living Faith International to re-establish discipleship training in Kenya.

Then another African nation opened to us - Ethiopia. Along with a team, I went to conduct a church meeting and a Ministers Conference with the purpose of establishing and training disciples and starting a Bible School. As I arrived at the conference, I noticed people were packed in the parking area and in a tent set







up outside. As I walked into the building, people were packed inside on the lower and upper levels! People were packed in everywhere to hear! When it was my turn to speak I told them I was going to tell a story specifically about Ethiopia. You can imagine they were eager to hear. The story was about an eleven year old girl that the Holy Spirit told she was going to marry a man who would take the Gospel to Africa. That little girl was Carolyn Savelle. Then I shared about being in that room in Kenya thirty years ago when God had Ethiopia on His heart and Dr. Savelle spoke about JSMI coming to Ethiopia. I explained how we had to wait on God's due season and His connection that can only be put together by God. The atmosphere changed, as they began jumping up and rejoicing, realizing God had them on His heart thirty years ago! Ears were now open to hear the uncompromised Word of God! God never forgets a mandate! Ethiopia's Bible School began last year with 50 students (five-fold minsters) who represent over a million people in those churches.

No matter what nation people come from, Dr. Savelle's heart has always been to train disciples. For years, one of his heart's desires has been to take the Gospel to the Cuban people. Last year he was invited to do a Ministers Conference in Cuba through Dan Stratton and Kelvin Box's churches. Dr. Savelle, John Bendixen, Tony Armstrong and I, met them in Cuba, and together this team had a mighty move of God. All of us fell in love with the Cuban people and were honored to share the Gospel with them. Because of this, JSMI is exploring opportunities to further disciple them in the Word. Praise God!

For many years Dr. Savelle and I have loved min-



istering to the Native American people because we have that heritage in our families' immediate bloodline. This past year, in Arizona, we were honored to open a Bible School on the Navajo Reservation working alongside Covenant of Faith Ministries. In Canada we conducted our first Graduation ceremony for the 1st Nations class on the Key Reserve, where nine out of the ten students graduated. At the banquet, a young woman who was the Valedictorian, gave a 35 minute speech, surprising everyone in the room who knew her as they testified that she would normally have never been able to do this. It was obvious that the Bible School and education that she received from the Key Reserve had changed her entire life. Another handsome young Native man, dark braids down his back and dressed in a leather vest, testified how someone forced him to take the school! He would study the Word in his 'dope' room while doing drugs. The Word changed his life drastically because that room is now his prayer and study room, and of course, he stopped doing drugs. All the glory goes to God!

This is why we train disciples! And anyone who knows those disciples can see the changes God has made in them. To change people's lives is why we start more schools, seed materials, have church and conference meetings. Someone asked me one time what it cost to educate a pastor, or leader with a one year course on the mission field. For \$100 JSMI can provide a 1 year course that will change their lives and change the lives of the people around them! If 2019 is anything like last year, we look forward to what God is going to do through His marvels, wonders and extraordinary manifestations! We are ready to see the greatness of our God!







It was ten months after I was born again in March of 1994 that my first YWAM mission trip was coming to an end. I, along with in my heart that we, the individuthe rest of the team, was finally al believers in the Body of Christ, seated in the bus, which was just beginning to pull away from the small village located on the border between Guatemala and Honduras. As I stared out the window, I looked into the eves of those we were leaving behind. Suddenly, I was overwhelmed with emotion as I realized what God had just given me: the opportunity to deposit His hope in His parents in the book of Luke another person's life. I had an instant knowing on the inside of me that this is what I wanted to in My Father's house and about do for the rest of my life.

In my mind, I've gone back to that moment many times. And now, twenty-five years later, I changed. It still burns to bring hope to the hopeless, peace to who sit in darkness.

After returning from a recent mission trip to Kenya, I find myself with the same thoughts and the same heart cry: I just want to be used by You God! I reflect on the lives we were able to connect His Father's will. To Jesus, fulwith and impart into. Whether in filling His assignment was never the children's home or with Bible school students or working with KSCF (Kenya Student Christian Fellowship), we saw miraculous things take place. Our entire trip was marked by the glory of God. The team saw lives changed, deaf ears opened, healings everywhere we went, demons cast out, and young people filled with the Holy Spirit. Our Heritage of Faith team flowed together, and I believe not only were the Kenyans impacted, but we were changed as well.

However, the main point I want

vou to take hold of is the fact that God wants to use you, as well! There is such a sense of urgency must be about the Father's business. Too many times we are waiting for someone else to step up to do His work, not realizing that God wants to use all of us. God wants to use vou!

Iesus lived with this same sense of urgency in His own individual life. As a twelve-vear-old boy, He expressed this urgency to when He stated, "Didn't you know it is necessary for Me to be My Father's business?" (see Luke 2:49). Later, after His ministry began, Jesus told His disciples, "I must work the works of Him can truly say my heart hasn't who sent Me" (John 9:4). He also said, "Behold here I am, coming to do Your will, O God—[to fulthe broken, and light to those fill] what is written of Me in the volume of the Book" (Hebrews 10:7 AMP). I am coming to do Your will!

> These scriptures show that with His own assignment, Jesus had a sense of urgency to fulfill about Him displaying His greatness; it was about showing His

Father God's will towards men, His goodness and greatness, as the Father worked with Him and through Him. His success was because of working with God the Father, not because He did His own will. According to Acts 10:38, "God anointed the man Jesus with the Holy Spirit—with His power, strength, and ability—and then Jesus was able to go around ...doing good and healing all who were oppressed of the devil. for God was with Him".

Towards the end of 2018 the Holy Spirit brought the word synergy up in my heart, revealing to me what I want you to get from the main point. He said, "The season that you're stepping into is not just a season to go to two services, but it's a season of synergy."

The word synergy means "two or more things come together to make something greater." As I researched synergy, I realized that everything we see in the natural world would not exist if synergy wasn't taking place. For example, if synergy wasn't taking place humans wouldn't have one of life's greatest needs, H2O, the compound substance we know as water. Water is made from just the right amount of the single element of hydrogen mixed with





just the right amount of the single element oxygen; the result is water. Every compound substance known to man is made up of single and different types of atoms, or elements, combining and working together to make something greater to enhance our lives. And then I discovered that even the single atom, or element, itself is actually made up of three tiny particles combining and working together. Once again we have synergy.

As I thought about that word synergy, and what the Holy Spirit was saying, I realized He was revealing to me that it's not just about the changes we make in the natural as a church, but it's about God and the Holy Spirit working together in you and me to make something greater.

As I was studying, I found 1 Corinthians 3:9: "For we are labourers together with God... God's husbandry... God's building" (KJV). The phrase "labourers together" is the Greek word synergos, and it's where we get the word synergy. God wants to use you and me, but He wants us to know and understand that it's

not you or me stepping out alone; rather it's Him working with and in us to do His work. Whatever assignment He gives us, we need to realize the power of synergy: God is working with us and He is working in us to accomplish something greater.

As 1 Corinthians 3:9 continues on it says, "we are God's husbandry." Now that's not a word I use: husbandry? Husbandry means you and I are His cultivated field. You and I are His, and He has prepared us to produce fruit. He wants to use you and me.

He created you with purpose. There is not one person reading this who was created without significance. Ephesians 2:10 says, "For we are His workmanship, created in Christ Jesus unto good works, which God before ordained that we should walk in them. He created you and He called you because His desire is to use you."

Make this your daily confession: God created me, therefore He wants to use me!

My heart is for you to realize that God wants to use you. Jesus instructed us and said, "As the Father has sent Me, I also send you" (John 20:21). Just as Jesus said, "Behold, I have come—In the volume of the book it is written of Me" (Hebrews 10:7), know there are things written in the book about you. Believers, we are told in Mark 16:15, "Go into all the world and preach the gospel..." and in Matthew 28:19, "Go [you] therefore, and teach all nations..." (KVJ).

So have a sense of urgency and step out to be used by God. Bring hope to the hopeless; bring the good news everywhere you go. He wants to use you. Then we can say like Jesus, "Behold, I come to do Your will, O God; in the volume of the book it's written of me. Behold, Justin and Annette come to do your will, O God: in the volume of the book it's written of me."


Can you, or will you, put your name there and say, "Behold comes to do Your will, O God: in the volume of the book it's written of me"?

Making Winners in Life is Discipleship

If you have been following Dr. Savelle for any time at all, then you've no doubt heard him describe one of the mandates of God on his life as "making winners in life." God expects him to take what he has learned from the Word and train people to win in life, right here, right now. Wow! That's a tall order from the Lord. But we know that what God asks us to do, He will equip us to do.

Making winners in life is actually about discipleship: teaching people how to become disciples of Jesus, or "disciplined ones," through the Word of God. Discipleship is exactly what Jesus modeled with His twelve disciples for three and a half years on the Earth. Day and night He lived with them, breaking bread with them, traveling and working with them, teaching them, and correcting them, in order to make them winners in life and eventually fishers of men. And in Acts we witness these "disciplined ones," Peter, James and John, Paul, Priscilla and Aquila, and many others, turn the world upside down for God.

The gift of the recreated Godlike spirit of a man, or the new man, that a believer receives at salvation is the greatest miracle. But in order to live in total victory like God wants us to, we must

pursue the same kind of intimate relationship with the Lord that the early disciples had through their constant fellowship with the Living Word. It is no different for believers today; we need to daily fellowship intimately with God through His Word, and learn His ways. Intimate fellowship shows us how He thinks, how He lives, acts, and speaks. It answers the question, what is He calling me to do? The new creation (our new man) must be trained through discipleship.

Notice, Jesus didn't call the disciples into life with Him to accomplish great things and then leave them to figure out how to do it. In fact, He told them at the Last Supper, "If you are not connected to Me, the Vine, there will be no fruit." This implies that even though He was leaving them physically, He was expecting to continually work with them as they spread the "Good News" of the Kingdom. At that same time Jesus also told them, "Those who truly love me are those who obey my commands" (John 14:21 TPT) and, "You show that you are my intimate friends when you obey all that I command you" (John 15:14 TPT). Well, if you don't know what His commands are, then isn't it reasonable to say you can't really obey or love

Him the way He wants you to? To become intimate friends, two people must spend much quality time together, for this is the only way they can know how each other thinks and acts.

The word intimate, according to Webster's 1828 dictionary, means "one to whom the thoughts of another are entrusted without reserve." Powerful insight! Psalm 33:11 confirms this idea and says, The counsel of the Lord stands forever, the thoughts of his heart through all generations (NRSV). His thoughts are His counsel; He inspired men to write them down in His Word, leaving them for us and for all generations. That Word has the power in it to save us-spirit, soul, and body. According to that written Word, 2 Timothy 3:16 says, Every Scripture is Godbreathed (given by His inspiration) and profitable for instruction, for reproof and conviction of sin, for correction of error and discipline in obedience, [and] for training in righteousness (in holy living, in conformity to God's will in thought, purpose, and action), so that the man of God may be complete and proficient, well fitted and thoroughly equipped for every good work. (AMP).

This scripture sounds exactly like what Jesus, the Word in the flesh, did daily with His disciples while He was here on the Earth. Iesus wants His intimate friends of today to become powerful instruments of His, to carry on His work here on this Earth as the early disciples did.

Now there is no way Dr. Savelle can physically be with you like Jesus was with His disciples, but he can mentor you daily with indepth practical teachings from the Word. In the early 90s Dr. Savelle began an on-campus Bible school to fulfill his mandate. Students came from all over the U.S. and the world to be trained in the Word and ministry. Then, in the early 2000s, the Lord instructed Dr. Savelle to change his methods and create a "school without walls" that would retain the on-campus experience of in-depth teaching. One that anyone could attend in the comfort of their own home, work on in their own time, and at their own convenience. The Lord told Dr. Savelle, "I have too many people that I have called into ministry who will not be able to fulfill their call, and those who need the in-depth teaching of the foundations of the Word that cannot leave their jobs, uproot their families, and move to go to Bible school." Thus the founding of the Jerry Savelle Bible Correspondence School.

People were able to do their studies at home and correspond

through the mail. Shortly after that a CD-ROM program was developed so the students could go paperless by working on their computers and sending in work through email. Then came the expansion and use of the Internet, and an online program was developed as well.

At some point the Lord then revealed to Dr. Savelle that he was involved in mass discipleship just like one of his mentors, Dr. T. L. Osborn, was involved in mass evangelism. Amazing! The Lord has made it easy to become His disciple, if people are willing to take the time and effort to go deep and study the Word.

Since it began, this "school without walls" has been successfully used for discipleship, not only in the USA, but also in Canada, the United Kingdom, and Australia. It is also being used successfully in several nations in Africa to train pastors, who then go back to their churches and teach the uncompromised Word of God. That one change in method from an on-campus setting to a "school without walls" has allowed thousands of God's people all over the world to be able to fulfill their call from God.





Just as Old Testament priests were considered gifts of God to the people. New Testament men and women who are called of God to serve in an office of Elijah's life. At the time, the land ministry are considered gifts to the Body of Christ. In his letter to the churches of Galatia, the apostle Paul said, "Let him that is taught in the word communicate unto him that teacheth in all good things" (Galatians 6:6 KJV). The word communicate literally means "to sow" or "to contribute." A stronger word in modern vernacular is partner. In other words, Paul said believers are to partner with those who teach and train us in the Word of God.

Sowing into the Anointing

When we sow into a ministry, we are not just sowing into an individual; we are also sowing into his or her anointing. The apostle Paul goes on to say, ... for whatever a man sows, that he will also reap. For he who sows to his flesh will of the flesh reap corruption, but he who sows to the Spirit will of the Spirit reap everlasting life (Galatians 6:7–8). We can sow to the flesh or we can sow to the Spirit. When we sow into those whom God considers gifts to the Body of Christ, we sow into their anointings—this is considered by God to sow into the Spirit.

Paul commended the believers in Philippi for repeatedly sowing into his ministry, saying, ... of grace (Philippians 1:7). The Amplified Bible uses the term spiritual blessing in place of the word grace. In essence Paul said, "You've not only sown into my life as an individual or as a gift of God, but you've also sown into the spiritual blessing that is upon me." The spiritual blessing Paul spoke of was the anointing of God on his life.

Let's look at the Old Testament account of the widow who sowed into the anointing that was upon was in drought and food was scarce; yet Elijah asked the woman for food and drink.

So she said, "As the Lord your God lives, I do not have bread, only a handful of flour in a bin and a little oil in a jar; and see, I am gathering a couple of sticks that I may go in and prepare a meal for myself and my son, that we may eat it, and die."

And Elijah said to her, "Do not fear; go and do as you have said, but make me a small cake from it first, and bring it to me; and afterward make some for yourself and your son. For thus says the Lord God of Israel: 'The bin of flour shall not be used up, nor shall the jar of oil run dry, until the day the Lord sends rain upon the earth."

So she went away and did according to the word of Elijah; and she and he and her household ate for many days (1 Kings 17: 12-15).

As a result of that woman's sowing into the anointing upon Elijah's life, she enjoyed a lifetime of harvest and miracles.

Elisha was a young man who also sowed into Elijah's anointing, as he followed the prophet and attended to his wants and needs. When the time came for Elijah to be taken up, he said you are all partakers with me to Elisha, "Ask! What may I do for you, before I am taken away from you?" (2 Kings 2:9). Elisha asked that a double portion of the prophet's spirit would be upon him—and he got it.

Harvest and Miracles

We too can enjoy a lifetime of harvest and miracles. I know

this is true because I've done it. I sowed into Oral Roberts's anointing. I sowed into Kenneth Copeland's anointing. I sowed into T.L. Osborn's anointing. When I sowed into these anointings, I got back not only financial blessings and favor, but I also received a portion of each man's anointing. I don't know any investment company on planet Earth that promises this kind of return.

I encourage you to believe for financial harvest on every seed you sow; after all, God never forgets a seed we've sown and He promises we can expect a harvest. But more importantly, I've found that sowing into another's anointing brings an increased anointing in my life far greater than any financial harvest—because the anointing can do what money can't do.
