

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
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## **PRAY THIS PRAYER**

said, "In the midst of more and more chaos and disorder, I will open My hand and freely give to those who refuse to be shaken."

But there's more.

The second part of the word the Lord gave me is that He is accelerating things and will provide for us unstoppable momentum. The Message paraphrase of 1 Corinthians 2:9 says, No one's ever seen or heard anything like this, never so much as imagined anything quite like it—what God has arranged for those who love him. As we move through 2022, this acceleration and momentum is what we are to expect!

Some may say, "Well, Brother Jerry, that sounds good when you say it, but can God really do such things in the midst of a world that seems to have gone mad?" Yes, He can! Our generation is not the first to question God's ability to perform His Word, as

experienced in the wilderness after God had miraculously delivered them out of Egypt. And the LORD said to Moses, "Has the LORD's arm been shortened? Now you shall see whether what I say will happen to you or not" (verse 23 NKJV). In modern vernacular, the Lord said, "Has the divine power of God been diminished?" Or it could be said this way: What has God not vet done to convince you that His power is always unlimited?

God hasn't changed, His hand hasn't been shortened, and His power has not been diminished. So, when He says we are going to experience divine acceleration, God is talking about supernatural ability to bring His plans, His purposes, and His will to pass at a much faster rate.

Now-I want to make this clear—I am not suggesting that we are no longer required to stand in faith for God's promises; rather, THE PERSON NAMED IN COLUMN 1 to a higher level. Doing so is what it will take to experience God's divine acceleration and unstoppable momentum, as prophesied through Amos: "Behold, the days are coming," says the LORD, "When the plowman shall overtake the reaper, and the treader of grapes him who sows seed; the mountains shall drip with sweet wine, and all the hills shall flow with it" (Amos 9:13). God is talking about divine acceleration, supernatural acceleration.

Let's look at Amos 9:13 in The Message paraphrase: "Yes indeed, it won't be long now." GOD's Decree. "Things are going to happen so fast your head will swim, one thing fast on the heels of the other. You won't be able to keep up. Everything will be happening at once—and everywhere you look, blessings! This sounds a lot like God's promise in **Deuteronomy 28:**

And all these blessings shall come upon you and overtake you, because you obey the voice of the LORD your God:

Blessed shall you be in the city, and blessed shall you be in the country.

Blessed shall be the fruit of your body, the produce of your ground, and the increase of your herds, the increase of your cattle and the offspring of your flocks.

Blessed shall be your basket and your kneading bowl.

Blessed shall you be when you come in, and blessed shall you be when you go out (verses 2–6).

This is where we are headed—with unstoppable momentum! Right now, God is positioning you to experience His divine acceleration, a supernatural surge, and a supernatural moving forward. Expect it. Talk about it in your home, with your family, and with those of like precious faith.

## Water to Wine or Divine Acceleration

The Bible tells us that if all the miracles Jesus performed were written down, there would not be enough books in the world to record them. Most of us are familiar with the first recorded miracle of Jesus turning water to wine in John, chapter two.

While Jesus and His disciples attended a wedding in Cana of Galilee, His mother came to Him and said the hosts had run out of wine. This unfortunate occurrence was a major social mistake that could shame the family for a long time to come because it was considered a great dishonor for a host to fail to provide adequate hospitality for his guests.

Jesus instructed the servants to gather six thirty-gallon stone pots and fill them with water. When the pots were filled to the brim He said, "Draw out now, and bear unto the governor of the feast" (John 2:8 KJV). The water turned immediately to wine when it was poured into the cup of the governor of the feast—a miracle of divine acceleration.

You may ask, "What does Jesus turning water to wine have to do with divine acceleration?" Let's put the wine-making process into context, considering a typical California vineyard, and the length of time it takes from planting a vine to opening a bottle of wine. The grapes first grow and ripen. They must then be harvested, pressed, allowed to ferment, and clarified. After aging in a barrel, wine is then bottled, but it is not ready to drink for two more years. The entire process takes four-to-eight years to complete, yet Jesus made it happen in mere moments in a demonstration of divine acceleration, of which the Bible says, This beginning of signs Jesus did in Cana of Galilee, and manifested His glory (John 2:11). In other words, divine acceleration is a manifestation of God's glory!

In his book titled *Miracles*, C.S. Lewis said of the John 2 story, "Jesus short-circuited the process," yet there's more to consider in this account of divine acceleration. Notice the six water pots each held about thirty gallons of water, and they were filled to the brim. Once the water was turned to wine, the resulting 180 gallons of wine was much more than a wedding party could consume. Not only did Jesus demonstrate divine acceleration, but He also demonstrated that He could provide more than enough to meet the need.

## Jesus Doesn't Change

Most of us are familiar with Hebrews 13:8, which says *Jesus Christ is the* 

same yesterday, today, and forever. The Amplified Bible, Classic Edition, says, Jesus Christ (the Messiah) is [always] the same, yesterday, today, [yes] and forever (to the ages), and The Message paraphrase says, For Jesus doesn't change—yesterday, today, tomorrow, he's always totally himself.

So, if Jesus performed miracles of divine acceleration in His earthly ministry, why don't we see Him do the same more frequently now? The reason we don't experience more incidents of divine acceleration in our lives is simple: we don't expect it. God spoke these words through the prophet Jeremiah: "I will hasten My word to perform it" (Jeremiah 1:12 KJV). The word hasten in this verse means "to move at a high speed." I like moving at a high speed, and I like it even better when God moves at a high speed!

As people of faith, we understand that there are times we must be willing to stand until we see the manifestation of what we are believing for. This principle of faith will never change; however, God is presently speeding up the process for us so that we don't have to stand for as long as we've done in the past. Our job is to expect to see this divine acceleration in our lives. And if we expect divine acceleration, then we need to talk about it, to decree it, for the Word of God says, You shall also decide and decree a thing, and it shall be established for you; and the light [of God's favor] shall shine upon your ways (Job 22:28 AMPC).

Jesus said that whoever does not doubt in his heart, but believes that those things he says will be done, he will have whatever he says (Mark 11:23). When we speak forth those things for which we believe, we release our faith. This is what I do, it's the way I live, so I want you to join me right now and release


your faith as we decree these words together: "This is my season for experiencing the open hand of God, and I expect to see unusual, extraordinary, and supernatural provision. I expect divine acceleration and unstoppable momentum as God hastens His word to perform it in my behalf!"

Jesus was famous for these words: According to your faith be it unto you (Matthew 9:29 KJV). But when I read this verse in The Passion Translation, the words exploded in my heart: "You will have what your faith expects!"

What is your faith expecting today?

Jesus began His earthly ministry with a miracle of divine acceleration. Could it be that in the last days, just before His appearing and the catching away of the saints, Jesus will again perform miracles of divine acceleration as a sign of the age?

If so, let's be ready to receive those miracles!



So Jesus came again to Cana of Galilee where He had made the water wine. And there was a certain nobleman whose son was sick at Capernaum. When he heard that Jesus had come out of Judea into Galilee, he went to Him and implored Him to come down and heal his son, for he was at the point of death. Then Jesus said to him, "Unless you people see signs and wonders you will by no means believe."

The nobleman said to Him, "Sir, come down before my child dies!"

Jesus said to him, "Go your way; your son lives." So the man believed the word that Jesus spoke to him, and he went his way. And as he was now going down, his servants met him and told him, saying, "Your son lives!"

Then he inquired of them the hour when he got better. And they said to him, "Yesterday at the seventh hour the fever left him." So the father knew that it was at the same hour which Jesus said to him, "Your son lives." And he himself believed and his whole household (John 4:46–53).

## Bible examples of divine acceleration

Can you and I expect breakthroughs to happen quickly? We certainly can in a season of *divine acceleration and unstoppable momentum*. Though we don't see these two modern-day terms in the Bible, the principle is nonetheless demonstrated, as we'll see in these five Bible stories:

The miracle of divine acceleration happened the same moment Jesus spoke the word. Can we not expect the same results?

Jesus speaks a word and immediately heals a leper.

And it happened when He was in a certain city, that behold, a man who was full of leprosy saw Jesus; and he fell on his face and implored Him, saying, "Lord, if You are willing, You can make me clean."

Then He put out His hand and touched him, saying, I am willing; be cleansed." Immediately the leprosy left him. And He charged him to tell no one, "But go and show yourself to the priest, and make an offering for your cleansing, as a testimony to them, just as Moses commanded" (Luke 5:12–14).

Of course, this isn't the only Bible account of Jesus healing a leper. He healed ten lepers at one time as they went to see the priest; however, in the Luke 5 instance He healed the man instantly, a miraculous demonstration of divine acceleration.

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### ADVENTURES IN FAITH

Jesus speaks a word and immediately heals the Centurion's servant.

Now when Jesus had entered Capernaum, a centurion came to Him, pleading with Him, saying, "Lord, my servant is lying at home paralyzed, dreadfully tormented."

And Jesus said to him, "I will come and heal him."

The centurion answered and said, "Lord, I am not worthy that You should come under my roof. But only speak a word, and my servant will be healed. For I also am a man under authority, having soldiers under me. And I say to this one, 'Go,' and he goes; and to another, 'Come,' and he comes; and to my servant, 'Do this,' and he does it."

When Jesus heard it, He marveled, and said to those who followed, "Assuredly, I say to you, I have not found such great faith, not even in Israel! And I say to you that many will come from east and west, and sit down with Abraham, Isaac, and Jacob in the kingdom of heaven. But the sons of the kingdom will be cast out into outer darkness. There will be weeping and gnashing of teeth." Then Jesus said to the centurion, "Go your way; and as you have believed, so let it be done for you." And his servant was healed that same hour (Matthew 8:5–13).

The Roman centurion, a military officer responsible for a company of 100 soldiers and certainly not a man considered a "follower of Jesus," nevertheless approached the Lord according to his understanding of authority. Jesus declared that He'd not found such great faith even in Israel, and when He spoke a word of divine acceleration, the servant was healed that same hour.

A woman reaches out to touch Jesus' garment, and is instantly healed.

Now a certain woman had a flow of blood for twelve years, and had suffered many things from many physicians. She had spent all that she had and was no better, but rather grew worse. When she heard about Jesus, she came behind Him in the crowd and touched His garment. For she said, "If only I may touch His clothes, I shall be made well."

Immediately the fountain of her blood was dried up, and she felt in her body that she was healed of the affliction (Mark 5:25–28).

The Message paraphrase of verse 28 says, The moment she did it, the flow of blood dried up. Again, the results were immediate!

Jesus speaks a word and immediately restores a man's hearing and voice.

Then they brought to Him one who was deaf and had an impediment in his speech, and they begged Him to put His hand on him. And He took him aside from the multitude, and put His fingers in his ears, and He spat and touched his tongue. Then, looking up to heaven, He sighed, and said to him, "Ephphatha," that is, "Be opened."

Immediately his ears were opened, and the impediment of his tongue was loosed, and he spoke plainly

(Mark 7:32-35).

The Bible contains many more examples of divine acceleration, where we see Jesus make things happen immediately. If He did it then, He can still do it!

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# FAITH NOT BY JOE MCCROSKEY

As believers, we should exercise our faith all the time. Whether in a crisis or not in a crisis, we all should use our faith and let it grow daily. The highest expression of faith is to praise God before anything happens, so we should wake up every day, praise Him, and thank Him for our day. To do so is to exercise our faith. From the moment we get up, we are to put our trust in God—no matter what comes throughout the day. We are to bring faith into the now, and we are to do it every day.

Faith now (bringing faith into the now) is for anything: finances, marriage, healing, family matters, a court case, and the list goes on. No matter what we may currently face, or may face in the future, we must continually bring our faith into the now. We must do the things we've seen and heard in the Word. Whether we hear a Bible truth for the first time, or we've heard it for fifty years, faith now is in the doing of the Word. For example, let's say you need healing, and then you hear the biblical principle of prayer cloths. Get one and pin it to you! When you hear the Word, faith comes, but then

immediately do the Word that you hear, bringing faith into your now.

The Mark 5 story of the woman with the issue of blood is one example of faith now. When she heard of Jesus the Healer, she brought her faith into the now. What did she do? First, she recognized Jesus as her healer. She allowed what God could do for her to override what man could do for her. Despite the religious law forbidding her to be around others due to her condition, she determined that she would touch the hem of His garment and be healed. Second, she spoke her faith, and lastly, she put her feet to work to go find Him. Because she brought her faith into her now, she touched His garment and was made whole. She was made whole, which means "as if it never existed."

We also read in Mark 5 about a man named Jairus, who came to Jesus seeking healing for his daughter. While he was with Jesus, the report came that his daughter had died.
Then Jesus turned to him and said, "Do not fear. Only believe." Jairus heard the word of the Lord, received it, and then faith came. When faith came into his now, he then went with Jesus to see his daughter, and she was raised from the dead.

## Faith Now vs. COVID-19

In November of 2020, I contracted COVID-19. I had no idea it was coming; in fact, contracting COVID had not even entered my mind. It had neither occurred to me that I would get it, nor had I feared it. But it came—straight from the devil to steal, kill, and destroy my life. The cough was the worst symptom, and it began to affect my oxygen level, so my doctor instructed me to go to the emergency room.

On the way to the E.R. I thanked God that I'd learned to praise Him each day for my health, and I activated my faith now, not for a moment expecting that I would get a bad report and be admitted. The medical staff verified that my oxygen level was low, but they couldn't

bring it up because the cough had turned to pneumonia and was affecting my lungs. That's when they admitted me to the hospital.

I had neither any fear nor any thought of dying as they prepared to take me to my room via a wheelchair. However, when they rolled me out of the elevator onto the COVID floor, fear and death were there to meet me. Immediately I declared, "I bind the spirit of death on this floor. It will have no effect on me!" When I spoke those words with my mouth, I brought my faith into the now. I was doing Romans 10:8: "The word is near you, in your mouth and in your heart." But I also understood that I had to do as Paul says in 2 Corinthians 13:5: Examine yourselves as to whether you are in faith. When facing something like I was facing, I needed faith now.

My confidence was (and is) in God, not in any man or doctor—though I'm thankful for physicians. When the nurse pushing my wheelchair heard the words I spoke, she said, "So, you know about spiritual authority?" I said, "I do," and then when I got to my room I declared, "Spirit of death, you cannot come through that door or enter this room!" There was a peace in my room that even the nurse and doctor noticed. I continued to build an atmosphere of faith now, applying the truth of Hebrews 11:3: By faith we understand that the worlds were framed by the word of God.

As my condition worsened, I could feel death knocking, but I refused to allow it in. I continued to do what I'd been taught. I was so weak that all I could do was listen to songs of faith—but not just any songs of faith. The number one song I listened to was "Our God Reigns Here" by John Waller. I now recommend anyone facing a critical health issue to get this song and listen to it. Psalm 32:7 says, You are my hiding place; You shall preserve me from trouble; You shall surround me with songs of

deliverance. That song surrounded me, strengthened my mind, and helped to deliver me.

## **Faith Comes by Hearing**

Though it seemed my condition was getting worse, I didn't confess that I was worse; rather, I continued to confess health and life to my body. I was doing what I'd been trained to do: calling those things that did not exist as though they did and, contrary to hope, in hope believed (see Romans 4:17–19).

Since all I could do was listen, I pulled up videos of people whom I knew would preach faith and energize my spirit man. I listened to Brother Hagin, Charles Capps, and Brother Jerry—all men of faith. As I listened to words of faith and life, I declared, "I receive that in my body now." I was doing Romans 10:17: So then faith comes by hearing, and hearing by the word of God.

On the morning of the third day, I felt a little better, and I thought to myself, I need to minister to others. I knew of another brother who was also in the hospital going through the same thing, so I sent him the song and many of the videos. I also prayed for him and encouraged him as I Face-Timed him so that we could speak face-to-face. As I spoke faith to him, that faith was also energizing and working for me—in the now. Without realizing it, I was working James 5:16: *Pray for one another, that you may be healed.* 

When the doctor came to my room at the end of that third day, she was amazed at what she saw. I said, "I told you, Doc, you do the doc-pills and I'll do the gospel, and we'll beat this thing." By bringing faith now into my room and my very being—spirit, soul, and body—I was being healed. I took the oxygen off that day and never used it again.

On the fourth day, the doctor proclaimed that my healing was

miraculous. She said that the medicine helped, but not to the degree of what she observed happening in me. Every one of the doctors and members of the medical staff that came to my room witnessed the miracle. They were used to seeing people die or, at best, stay in the hospital ten-to-thirty days before being released, yet I was released on the fifth day.

Now, even though I was released, I was not yet whole. I still had to exercise my faith now each day to restore my breathing and my strength. I continued to exercise my faith now until I had absolutely no effects of COVID.


If you still have effects from COVID or any other illness, exercise your faith now and get rid of them. Bringing your faith into the now, not the future and not the past, is crucial for the time in which we live. I guarantee you, not according to my word but according to the Word of God, that if you will do what you are reading about—bringing your faith into the now—that faith will work for you in any situation. Don't just read this article and rejoice with me that it worked for me, but also do it for yourself. Every time the devil comes knocking, answer with faith now.

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Then as He entered a certain village, there met Him ten men who were lepers, who stood afar off. And they lifted up their voices and said, Jesus, Master, have mercy on us! So when He saw them, He said to them, "Go, show yourselves to the priests." And so it was that as they went, they were cleansed (Luke 17:12-14).

Notice in this scripture that "AS THEY WENT, THEY WERE CLEANSED." Where were they going? They were doing what Jesus told them to do. He said, "Go, show yourselves to the priests." These lepers had approached Jesus when He came into town and asked Him for mercy. It's interesting how they addressed Jesus. They didn't just say "Jesus." They called Him "Jesus, Master." This word Master in the Greek means "the one fully authorized" or "commander" and refers to Jesus as "the head (owner) of

all things." This is significant that they came acknowledging Jesus' position and authority. By doing so they were saying: You have the authority to speak into our lives, and we will do whatever you say. And they did.

Jesus said in Mark 6:4, "A prophet is not without honor except in his own country, among his own relatives, and in his own house." Also in Matthew 10:41, Jesus said, "He who receives a prophet in the name of a prophet shall receive a prophet's reward." Many Christians see Jesus as their Savior or maybe their friend, but do they relate to him as their Master? Is He the Commander who is fully authorized and head over all things? Will they obey His commands? Their healing may depend on it.

Jesus then spoke a word to them. In any situation we are up against, we need a Word from God. We have the

written Word of God with which to live victoriously, but also we need a Rhema (spoken) Word from God for our particular situation. Often times, the Holy Spirit will remind me of something in the Word of God that pertains to a problem, and that scripture now becomes my Rhema (spoken) Word to overcome that situation. For example, Jesus told Peter to "Come" when Peter said if it is you, tell me to come. So Peter stepped out of the boat on a spoken word from Jesus. Because of this word from the Master, Peter was able to walk on water! What a miracle that was!

So back to the word Jesus spoke to these lepers. He told them to go show themselves to the priests. This was a requirement under the law that goes back to Leviticus concerning the cleansing of lepers. These lepers just simply obeyed what Jesus told them

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to do, and it says AS THEY WENT, THEY WERE CLEANSED. I wonder how many times we get a word from the Lord, and we don't go? When we get a word from the Lord, we must respond immediately.

Sometimes a word from the Lord can come from a man that God has anointed to deliver the word, and


None of this happened as Naaman had imagined or the part I threw in there for fun. Elisha didn't even come out himself. He sent his servant to give Naaman a command to go dip in the river Jordan seven times, and he would be cleansed. Naaman was so mad at this word. He thought there were other rivers that were cleaner and how dare Elisha not come out and give the word himself!

Naaman went away mad! Then his servant talked him into obeying the word that was given. Thank God for this servant. AS NAAMAN WENT and dipped in the river Jordan seven times, HE WAS CLEANSED.

I remember a story where the man of God got a word for a couple, who wanted to have a baby, to go buy purple sheets. Purple sheets? What does that have anything to do with having a baby? In this case...everything. They bought the purple sheets and less than a year later, the couple had a child. AS THEY WENT!

My father-in-law, Pastor Bob Montgomery, was diagnosed with stage 4 cancer and blood clots were found on his lungs. The situation was serious! He prayed and sought the Lord for a word concerning his situation. The Lord reminded him Jesus was three days in the grave then rose, and He told him to take three rounds of chemo and rise with healing in his hands. The whole church got behind this word and had twenty-four hour prayer for him, praying scriptures concerning healing for his body. AS HE WENT and did three rounds of chemo, HE WAS HEALED and is healed to this day - years later.

Bro. Joe McCroskey was preaching one time and had a word of knowledge of someone(s) wanting to have a child. He said if that's you, run down here to the altar. One lady ran down, and one lady walked down. He prayed for both ladies just the same. One lady conceived and had a child; the other did not. Guess which one got pregnant? It was the one who ran down as instructed. AS SHE WENT, SHE WAS HEALED. He has a picture of the baby in his office to this day. I wonder why the other lady didn't run down. Maybe she thought that it wasn't important.

Maybe she didn't want to look silly. Whatever the case may be, she did not receive her miracle.

One time Dr. Savelle instructed people with back problems to come to the altar. The Lord told him to have everyone lie face down on their stomachs in a row and then to run across their backs. Their backs were hurting. I think the last thing people with a hurting backs want is for someone to run across their backs. And probably the last thing someone wants to do to people with hurting backs is to run across their backs. However, everyone did as the Lord instructed them to do through Dr. Savelle. They lay down; he took his shoes off and ran across every one of their backs. AS THEY WENT, they were healed. Every single person was healed!

Notice in each of these examples of God's mighty exploits, there was a word from God through a man of God. As people obeyed the word, they received their healing.

It's very important to point out that when we receive a word from the Lord with specific instructions, that word has authority given by the Master. The phrase "AS THEY WENT" implies that when those lepers walked away from Jesus to do as He had commanded them, they went UNDER the authority of that word. That is so powerful. The Greek

definition implies that it was a "going under." When God gives us a word, we must submit to that word and obey.

Isaiah 10:27 says that the burden will be removed and the yoke destroyed because of the anointing. The anointing does not stop. It does not quit. People stop, and people quit. The anointing has just as much power the next day, the next week or even the next month or next year as it did when it was first administered. People get the idea that if something isn't instantaneous, that it didn't happen. That's a lie. Don't give up. Don't quit believing. The anointing is in you and working to destroy whatever yoke that has a hold on you and remove whatever burden that's on you. The anointing is on a "seek and destroy mission." Its mission is to destroy the works of the devil. There's nothing like bringing yourself UNDER the anointing.

Church, have you made Jesus your Master? Will you obey Him when He speaks a rhema word to you concerning your situation? Will you believe and submit to the anointing? For me and you, these are the victorious keys to "as they went, they were healed." AS YOU GO today, receive the healing power of Jesus Christ our Lord in your life in Jesus name.

I want to challenge you to believe for and declare that you will experience more suddenlies in your life—beginning

God essentially declared Himself the "God of the suddenlies" when He spoke through the prophet Isaiah, saying,

right now!

I have declared the former things from the beginning; They went forth from My mouth, and I caused them to hear it. Suddenly I did them, and they came to pass.

(Isaiah 48:3)

The original Hebrew word translated as suddenly in this verse means "straightaway; instantly." Notice that God spoke of things He had declared from the beginning—meaning a long time ago—yet when He brought them to pass, He did so suddenly, straightaway, instantly.





## the Suddenlies

Jesus said, "Most assuredly, I say to you, the Son can do nothing of Himself, but what He sees the Father do; for whatever He does, the Son does also in like manner" (John 5:19). Jesus had obviously observed His Father doing things suddenly, but to put His statement in Bible context, let's back up to the beginning of John chapter 5 and the account of a suddenly Jesus demonstrated in behalf of a man lying at the pool of Bethesda.

For an angel went down at a certain time into the pool and stirred up the water; then whoever stepped in first ... was made well of whatever disease he had. Now a certain man was there who had an infirmity thirty-eight years. When Jesus saw him lying there, and knew that he already had been in that condition a long time, He said to him, "Do you want to be made well?

The sick man answered him, "Sir, I have no man to put me into the pool when the water is stirred up; but while I am coming, another steps down before me."

Jesus said to him, "Rise, take up your bed and walk." And immediately the man was made well, took up his bed, and walked (John 5:4–8).

The Bible doesn't tell us this man's exact condition, but after having had it for thirty-eight years it's fair to say that society—both then and now—would deem it hopeless. Most people who've suffered with

something that long don't expect to recover, and this man was no different. Jesus first had to change the man's thinking, which is the reason He said, "Do you want to be made well?" That one question instilled enough hope and faith in the man that when Jesus said, "Rise, take up your bed and walk," that is just what the man did. In the twinkling of an eye—suddenly, straightaway, instantly—thirty-eight years of pain and suffering was behind him.

As believers, what we think is vital, and what we believe is vital—good or bad, positive or negative. What we have and experience in life is determined by what we think and believe, and ultimately speak. When we think constantly about negative and wrong things, that's exactly what we get. But when we keep our

minds stayed on God and choose to believe what He says in His Word despite our circumstances—we will attract every good thing the Bible says we can have. If we want to experience God's best, including His suddenlies, we may need to change the way we think.

## Stay in Faith

Accounts of God doing something suddenly for the benefit of people of faith are presented throughout both



the Old and New Testaments. Because we know that faith is the substance of things hoped for, the evidence of things not seen (Hebrews 11:1), I want to share some wisdom about the relationship between faith and suddenlies. As people of faith, we understand the importance of standing in faith and speaking words

of faith until we see the manifestation of what we are believing for. However, if we're not careful we can unintentionally get to the place where we're speaking the Word of God over our faith project,

yet not really expecting what we say to come to pass. Our confession becomes more wishful thinking than real Bible faith. This is not an uncommon occurrence when we've been standing for something for a long time.

If you've been standing for something for a long time and it seems your faith may have turned to wishful thinking, then get back in faith and declare the words God has spoken into this season: accelerating things and will provide for you unstoppable momentum." Because faith is the evidence of things not seen, God wants you to use your faith to see yourself rise up on the inside before you ever rise up on the

outside. See yourself delivered from debt, see your marriage restored, see your body healed, and see yourself possessing everything in this life that God says you can have. Through the eye of faith, you've got to see these things happen on the inside before they ever manifest on the outside.

## The Breakthrough Is Now

Jesus' friend Lazarus had been dead four days when Jesus arrived in Bethany. Many people had gathered to comfort Lazarus's sisters, Martha and Mary, and when the women heard Jesus was

coming, Martha went to meet Him.

Now Martha said to Jesus, "Lord, if You had been here, my brother would not have died. But even now I know that whatever you ask of God, God will give You."

Jesus said to her, "Your brother will rise again."

Martha said to Him, "I know that he will rise again in the resurrection at the last day."

Jesus said to her, "I am the resurrection and the life. He who believes in Me, though he may die, he shall live. And whoever

lives and believes in Me shall never die. Do you believe this?"

She said to Him, "Yes, Lord, I believe that You are the Christ, the Son of God, who is come into the world" (John 11:21–27).

When Jesus told Martha that her brother would rise again, He was talking about what He intended to do now—in the present—yet Martha put the promise off into the future: "I know that he will rise again in the resurrection at the last day."

In today's vernacular Jesus said, "Girl, I'm not talking about the last days. I'm talking about now. I AM the resurrection!"

Accompanied by Martha, Mary, and those who had come to comfort them, Jesus went to the tomb of Lazarus and ordered the stone that covered it be rolled away. He cried out in a loud voice, "Lazarus, come forth!" and suddenly—straightaway, instantly—Lazarus came out of his grave.

Not only is our God the God of the suddenlies, He is also the God of the

breakthrough. And the time of the breakthrough is now!

Join me now and pray this prayer out loud:

Heavenly Father,

Your Word declares that faith comes by

hearing and hearing by the Word of God. I've heard the Word today and faith is rising inside of me. I have reason to believe that I don't have to wait forever for the manifestation of what I'm believing for, though I'm willing to do so, for you are the God of the suddenlies and the God of the breakthrough.

I choose not to stagger at the promises of God, for I am fully persuaded that they belong to me. I am in covenant with You, and I believe You want to fulfill every promise to me now, in the name of Jesus.

Father, Your Word

declares that if I believe I receive when I pray, that I will receive your promises now. So, I believe and declare that I receive every need in my life met now, according to your Word. I believe you will do these things suddenly for me, and they will come to pass now. I pray these things in the name of Jesus, to the glory of God. Amen!



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Growing up I was a daydreamer and I had quite the imagination. From my backyard, with a tennis ball in hand, I could be anyone. One moment I could be Cal Ripken fielding a ground ball, throwing the runner out at first to win the game. The next minute I could be Jimmy Connors hitting the winning shot to take home the prized trophy at Wimbledon or Larry Bird hitting the fade away three to beat the Lakers. Imagination is great because we can dream about our potential and we can get an image of what should be and what we have a right to. That is the key: do you know what you have a right to? I'm not necessarily referring to becoming a sports hero unless that's what you are called to do. But do you know you have a right to be free, whole, prosperous, delivered . . . ? You have a right to have everything the WORD says you can have. I have had to be cautious about imagination because imagination is always something for the future. It's not a present reality. The enemy of my imagination becoming a reality is procrastination. The question I must ask myself is am I taking steps for my dream to become a reality or am I saying . . . One Day In The Future . . . ?

Years ago, I remember listening to every preaching cassette I could get my hands on. I came across Jesse Duplantis's message about "One More Night with the Frogs." The humor that he delivers in this message is so great, but the thought of it is sobering. I remember being in my Mazda MX-3 in the parking lot of my workplace when I was listening to this message. I rewound that certain part in the message and listened again and again. I would laugh at Pharaoh's response when he responded to Moses. When Moses asked if he wanted to be free of the frogs, he answered, "YES!! Tomorrow." We all laugh because we think our response would be RIGHT NOW!!! As I listened and laughed to what was being said over and over, the Holy Spirit spoke to me and said, "You're just like Pharoah and would settle for having one more night with the frogs." The Holy Spirit said, "you know you're called to be free from this, but you're still bound, and you keep saying one day this will not be a problem (FROGS). You know you're called to ministry, but you say tomorrow (ONE MORE NIGHT) you will develop the habits to grow."

Throughout scripture we see things associated



with time. On one hand, we can remember the things of yesterday-the breakthroughs, testimonies, and the memorials of days gone by. Praise the Lord for the victories we have experienced. On the other hand, we can focus on the promises and the things of the future. We can look forward to Christ's return and the great outpourings that come before that. According to Hebrews 13:8, Jesus Christ is the same yesterday, today, and forever. We are to bring what was and what will be into today, RIGHT NOW. There is nothing being withheld from you! Release your faith NOW! Faith is always right now. Before I close this article out, I want to leave you with some thoughts:

- 1. 2 Corinthians 6:2 says, *NOW* is the day of salvation. Do not spend one more night with the frogs. Your freedom, victory, and deliverance are right now. I do not have to feel free; I do not need to feel delivered! Just receive that right now is your appointed time of freedom.
- 2. Hebrews 3:15 says, today if you will hear His voice. Know that He is speaking now, and His voice is to always lead you in paths of righteousness. His voice is leading you right now in green pastures. Don't ever say you don't hear His voice. Today you hear His voice and

a stranger's voice you will not follow.
