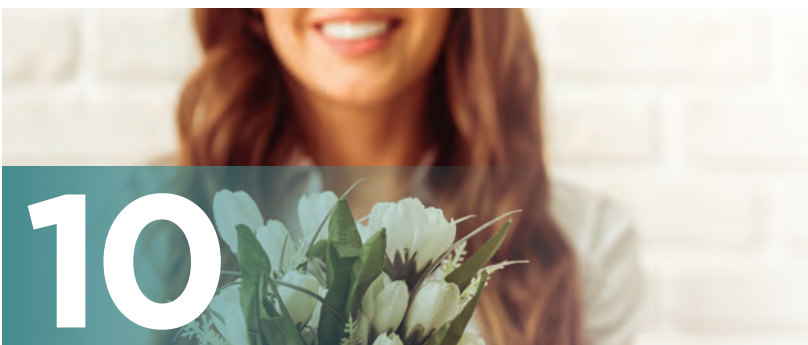

FINANCIAL INVERSION

I began to experience wealth transfer very, very early in my ministry. About 3 months into my walk with the Lord I was reading the Bible and came across this verse in Proverbs, “*A good man leaveth an inheritance to his children’s children: and the wealth of the sinner is laid up for the just*” (Proverbs 13:22).

That’s talking about a financial inversion. Now, I didn’t know that phrase back then, but I thought that was an interesting verse—“*the wealth of the sinner has been laid up for the just.*”

Well, I knew I was one of the *just* now! I began to experience this wealth transfer way back in 1969 and it is still flowing in my life today. God was *showing* me as a new believer that this was not just words that He put in Scripture because He couldn't think of anything else to say. No, It's prophetic!

I didn't grow up in a religious-minded atmosphere. I knew John 3:16; I knew that as a little boy. That was about all I knew the Bible said. So, when I finally surrendered myself to the Lord, I always approached the Word of God with this attitude, "God if You didn't mean what You said, tell me right now, and I won't bother with It anymore." He's never said, "I didn't mean what I said." So I take it literally.

Charles Capps prophesied back in 1978, "*Financial inversion shall increase, the economy shall go up and down, but those who have learned to walk in My Word, they shall see prosperity come forth in a way that they have never seen before. Yes, there is coming a financial inversion in the world's system. It's been held*

in reservoirs by wicked men, but the end is nigh. Those reservoirs shall be tapped and shall be drained for the Gospel of Jesus Christ...and you will see things that you have never dreamed would come to pass, particularly in your finances."

According to God's Word, wealth doesn't belong to the wicked, it belongs to the righteous. It's going to take more money in these last days to get the Gospel out to the masses than it has ever taken before. God's not having to invent more money. It's out there, but it's in the wrong hands.

In James 5:1-3 we see God speaking to the wicked:

"Go to now, ye rich men, weep and howl for your miseries that shall come upon you.² Your riches are corrupted, and your garments are moth-eaten.³ Your gold and silver is cankered; and the rust of them shall be a witness against you, and shall eat your flesh as it were fire. Ye have heaped treasure together for the last days."

That Scripture has a two-fold meaning—first, how the sinner is getting this wealth will come to an end. The second meaning is what they have been heaping up is reserved for the just in the last days.

In other words, God is saying to sinners, "*Oh you've been heaping it up. You've got treasuries of wealth, but you're not going to enjoy it in the last days, it will be taken from you!*"

LEARN TO CRY OUT FOR YOUR HARVEST!

In James 5 verse 4 we see that God has seen and heard everything: "*Behold, the hire of the labourers who have reaped down your fields, which is of you kept back by fraud, crieth: and the cries of them which have reaped are entered into the ears of the Lord of sabaoth.*" That's not sabbath, that's sabaoth. That means host or angels.

If you look very closely you will see that James is saying by the Spirit of God that there are two cries going on in the world right now:

1 The cry of the wages that have been held back from the righteous, &

2 The righteous are crying out for what rightfully belongs to them.

Notice, the *harvest* is crying, and the people that it belongs to *should* be crying. I'm not talking about crying tears of sorrow. I'm talking about a bold command, "***I want my harvest and I want it now!***" It doesn't belong to you, satan! It doesn't belong to the wicked! I'm crying out for my harvest!" And at the same time, your harvest is crying out, "Let me go! Let me get into the hands where I belong! Now release me!"

Most people don't cry out to their harvest because if their harvest doesn't come in the next hour or so after they sowed it, or doesn't come before dark, or the next morning, they tend to forget about it. How much harvest do you suppose you're entitled to that you gave up on?

Have you reaped all your harvest so far? If not, then It's being

held back; because the Bible makes it very clear, "...*whatsoever a man soweth, that shall he also reap.*" If you're not reaping what you sowed, that is a violation of spiritual law. So, it's being held back by somebody.

Put your hands up and say, "God, Your Word says the wealth of the sinner belongs to the righteous—I'm the righteous! I'm crying out for my harvest! Harvest come to me now in Jesus Name!"

You are going to reap the harvest that has been held back for a long time! God is going to cause a Divine Connection—your harvest *is* going to wind up in your hands!

THE HUNDREDFOLD RETURN, GOD'S BEST!

What could you do right now if a hundredfold harvest came to you from all this seed that you have sown? We could finance the Gospel around the world and not even dent our reserves!

God never forgets a seed sown. ²⁹ *And Jesus answered and said, Verily I say unto you, There is no man that hath left house, or brethren, or sisters, or father, or mother, or wife, or children, or lands, for My sake, and the Gospel's,*³⁰ *But he shall receive a hundredfold now in this time...* (Mark 10:29-30).

I was taught by the Lord in the early days of my ministry that the hundredfold return is God's best!

Many Word of faith pastors have said to me, "you can't go around telling people they'll get a hundredfold."

Well, Jesus did, and I'm quoting Him. So that's got to come to pass! It began years ago, but

it's picking up momentum NOW.

WORD OF THE LORD FOR 2023

We've entered into a new season, a new era, and NOW we're going to start seeing hundredfold testimonies—not occasionally, but it's going to become common place! Hundredfold means maximum results! Don't put limitations on the harvest. Don't settle for less. Hundredfold represents maximum, the highest level attainable.

God said, "**Tell the people that 2023 will be known as the year of the maximum. The year of the highest level attainable!**"

God's gives us a prophetic Word to raise our expectations. That's what happened to me the first time I heard Him say that Word for 2023 on October the 5th, my expectations went to another level. The moment I heard this is the year of the maximum, the year of the highest level attainable, I wrote it down and immediately began declaring it. I'm calling things that are not as though they are!

Psalms 62:5 says, "*My soul, wait thou only upon God; for my expectation is from Him.*" I have a right to expect this to come to pass, because it came from Him.

Get ready for 2023 to be the year of the maximum and a year for the highest level attainable *for you*, just like God said. Mix your faith with that Word now. Begin saying it. That's how you mix your faith with the Word of God. **Say it.** Jesus said, "... *whosoever shall SAY... you shall have what you SAY.*" There's power in your words.

Don't say, "Well, that's not likely to

happen to me.” Close your mouth! Guard your words. I’ve joked about this before, if you can’t speak the Word invest in some duct tape and keep your mouth closed until you can speak the Word.

Say this, “My expectation is from Him. I’m expecting from this moment forward maximum return on every seed sown, the highest level attainable.” Deuteronomy 8:18 says, *...Remember the Lord thy God for it is He who giveth thee the power to get wealth.*

When you’re experiencing maximum results and reaching the highest level attainable, people know that you’re not capable of making that happen in the natural, so the glory’s got to be given to God. He gives the power to get wealth.

Jesus said in Mark 9:23, *“...If thou canst believe, all things are possible to him that believeth.”*

Make a decision to believe the Word. Get all the seed in the ground that you possibly can. Look for opportunities to sow.

Carolyn and I get up in the morning and say, “Lord Your Word says in Galatians that we are to be mindful to be a blessing. Give us opportunities today where we can sow—where we can be a blessing.”

The Lord said to me years ago, “Write in the margin of your Bible, God never forgets a seed sown.” In Psalm 20:1-3 the psalmist said, *“The Lord hear thee in the day of trouble; the Name of the God of Jacob defend thee;² Send thee help from the sanctuary, and strengthen thee out of Zion;³ Remember all thy offerings...”* Notice—*“He remembers all your offerings.”*

What farmer sows a seed and expects a harvest of one apple? What farmer sows a seed and expects one stalk of corn? That’s not the law of

Genesis—every seed produces after its own kind. When the farmer takes the time to prepare the soil, and plant the seed, he’s expecting a far greater harvest than the amount or size of the seed that he sowed.

In Genesis 26:12, *“Isaac sowed in that land and received in the same year a hundredfold.”* What was Isaac’s harvest? A hundredfold. It goes on to say that he gained more and more until he became extremely rich. The Message Translation says, *“...he took in a huge harvest.”* Huge means vast, extremely large, immense, immeasurable, boundless.

Obviously he got back far greater than he had sown. In the *same* year. What did Jesus say in Mark 10:30, *“in this time.” “In this age.”* Don’t let your harvest die in the field. Don’t let your harvest stay in the wrong hands.

If Isaac could reap a hundredfold in the same year, and Jesus said we could reap a hundredfold in this time, then who are we going to believe? I’m going for the hundredfold. How about you?

Why should we be any different? We are in the year of the maximum. We are in the year of the highest level attainable. Go for it! Nothing is impossible for God, and nothing is impossible to them who believe!

POSITION YOURSELF FOR MAX-IMUM HARVEST WITH YOUR FAITH

Jesus said according to your *faith*, be it unto you. According to your faith let it be done.

The 1828 Noah Webster dictionary defines *faith* as *to draw towards something desired*. It uses as an example; faith is like a rope or a cable that is used to pull you toward a desired position. That’s what faith

does. It pulls you towards a desired result.

That’s what you must do if you want to experience this maximum and highest level. You’re going to have to pull yourself to it with your faith. Jesus said, *“...Go your way; and as you have believed, so let it be done for you”* (Matthew 8:13 NKJV).

Faith pulls the “what can be” into the realm of “what is!” Don’t just sit around and say, “well, if it’s to be, it will be.” No, you pull yourself to it with your faith. Maximum is what can be, but faith pulls it into the here and now.

Faith makes things happen. Jesus said in Matthew 9:22, *“...thy faith hath made thee whole.”* Faith makes what seems impossible, *possible*.

If maximum harvest sounds impossible to you, faith can make it possible! Matthew 17:20 tells us, *“...If you have faith...nothing shall be impossible unto you.”* The Message Translation says, *“...There is nothing you wouldn’t be able to tackle.”*

Your faith can take possession of your maximum harvest, and it can take possession of the highest level attainable.

Since it *can* do it, then my challenge to you is—*go for it!*

Born to be a Blessing

You are Called to be a Blessing

One special Sunday morning in 1975, I awoke with this thought branded on the inside of me: *I was born to be a blessing and I was born to be blessed.* Having that thought before me when I opened my eyes that day changed my life. Once I realized the calling of being a blessing, it was all I could dwell upon.

The Office of Being a Blessing
9 *Never return evil for evil or insult for insult (scolding, tongue-lashing, berating), but on the contrary blessing [praying for their welfare, happiness, and protection, and truly pitying and loving them]. For know that to this you have been called, that you may yourselves inherit a blessing [from God—that you may obtain a blessing as heirs, bringing welfare and happiness and protection] (1 Peter 3:9 AMPC).*

All Christians are called to be a blessing just like others are called into the ministry offices.

You have a divine appointment with God, and you will be held accountable for the office of being a blessing.

Give of Yourself

The very essence of life is giving.

You were not put on this earth to see how much you could acquire or accumulate during your life. You were put on this earth to see how much of your life you could give away.

You can be a tremendous blessing to someone just by telling him what you know about the Word of God. You may think you know only a little bit, but that little bit is enough to set someone free. You were born to be a blessing to everyone you contact.

The Blessings of God

God said to Abraham: ² *And I will make of thee a great nation, and I will bless thee, and make thy name great; and thou shalt be a blessing.*³ *And I will bless them that bless thee, and curse him that curseth thee: and in thee shall all families of the earth be blessed (Genesis 12:2-3).*

Abraham was going to be both blessed and a blessing. Our families are blessed because of faithful Abraham. This scripture doesn't say that only preachers and their families will be blessed - it says all families. There are no exceptions.

So many times, satan lies to people, telling them that certain Scriptures are only for preachers. The Word of God says that *all* families will be blessed.

Another Scripture which illustrates the blessings of God is Mark 10:29-30:

²⁹ *And Jesus answered and said, Verily I say unto you, There is no man that hath left house, or brethren, or sisters, or father, or mother, or wife, or children, or lands, for my sake, and the Gospel's, ³⁰but he shall receive an hundredfold....*

This scripture began to work for Jerry and me before we ever entered into the ministry. The Lord honors faith.

It doesn't matter where you are, or whether your occupation has anything to do with the Church. If you are in a service station pumping gas, or in a grocery store sacking groceries, God will meet your need because He honors His Word.

Instruments of Blessing

Jesus was a blessing. He was an instrument through which divine favor flowed in order to stop misfortune in our lives. We would have died and gone to hell if it had not been for Jesus being born on this earth.

Since we are also born on this earth as a blessing, we too are instruments divine favor flows through to stop misfortune in the lives of others. There is no greater honor than being a blessing to someone in need.

Many Ways of Blessing

It is more fun to give than to receive. If you will be obedient and sincere with God, He will show you how to be an instrument of blessing to stop misfortune in the lives of those around you. God will use you if you make yourself available to Him. There are many ways God can use you to be a blessing.

Giving an offering at church or writing a monthly check to a ministry is just one way of being a blessing. You might get up one morning and hear the Lord tell you to babysit for Mary Jane. The Lord may tell you to keep her children for the day and give her money to go to the beauty shop to get her hair done.

God might tell you to bake a cake for someone, take a couple out to dinner, or send someone flowers. Once we begin to be sensitive and obedient to what God tells us to do, we will be blessed by being a blessing.

When you begin to take care of the needs of others, God will make certain that all your needs are met. We must be obedient to do whatever He tells us to do, no matter how insignificant it may seem.

Obey God's Voice

You will be blessed because you obey the voice of God. When God speaks to you to do this or that, obey Him. Don't be moved by what a person looks like. The woman who wears diamonds and dresses in a mink coat may have just as great a need as the person wearing tattered clothes. Learn to be sensitive to what the Spirit of God tells you, rather than what your five senses dictate.

We can't judge a man by the clothes he wears, the house he lives in, or by anything else we can see with our natural eyes. We must learn to be sensitive to the Holy Spirit and obedient to God.

Choose The Blessings

God spoke the blessings into existence. We have a right to the same blessings as Abraham if we are obedient to the commandments of God.

God appeared on Mount Zion and spoke these blessings. The same words are still in effect today. The choice is given to us just like it was given to Abraham. We can choose blessings or curses.

I call heaven and earth to record this day against you, that I have set before you life and death, blessing and cursing: therefore choose life, that both thou and thy seed may live (Deuteronomy 30:19).

The blessings of Abraham are an established fact. All we must do to inherit them is to be obedient to the commandments of God. Abraham was faithful. He gave tithes to God before there was a law requiring the tithe.

Love Your Neighbor As Yourself

What is the great commandment? *Thou shalt love thy neighbour as thyself (Matthew 22:39).*

When we begin doing that, we become a blessing. When we begin thinking about our brother and sister, we automatically become blessed. The blessings of God have already been spoken - they are already here.

God Provides What We Need To Bless Others

God wants to give us the desires of our heart. And one of those desires should be to be a blessing to others. If we don't have what we need to be a blessing to someone, God will provide it supernaturally.

Desire God

Delight thyself also in the Lord; and He shall give thee the desires of thine heart (Psalm 37:4).

God knows the very desires of your heart. When He knows that you are there to love and serve Him, and that you desire *Him* above all others, you will not have to ask Him for anything. He knows what is in your heart, and He will cause the blessings to come on you and overtake you.

You don't need to go around confessing what you need all the time. If you begin giving your life to others, your needs will be met.

He will fulfil the desire of them that fear Him: He also will hear their cry, and will save them (Psalm 145:19).

You were born both to be a blessing and to be blessed. But most of all, you were born to desire God above everything else.

DRENCHED IN THE BLESSING

The other day I walked into a store to do my grocery shopping. It was beautiful and sunny outside when I walked in, with no indication of rain. However, when I walked out with my cart of groceries, it was a totally different story! It was pouring down rain, and I don't mean a little bit!

I ran to my car and by the time I reached it, I was completely soaked as if I had just walked out of a shower fully clothed! I had nothing to dry off with, so I drove home drenched from the unexpected downpour!

Then just a few days later, I came across this scripture in my reading time. It says, "*Life's blessings drench the honest and faithful person...*" (Proverbs 28:20 TPT). I got a very clear picture that rainy day of what drenched looks (and feels) like!

I want you to get a clear picture in your mind and see with the eye of your faith (deep down inside) what being drenched in God's blessings looks like for you! Everywhere you go—covered in the outpouring of His blessings.

Drench means to cover liberally. Picture your home, your business, your health, your children, your finances drenched in the blessings of God and soaked in the favor! My dad teaches us we are to wake up every day LOOKING, WATCHING, and EXPECTING it!

But I must point out *who* the "blessing drench" is for, and that is found in the rest of that scripture — the "faithful person."

A faithful person is committed, dedicated, loyal, unwavering NO MATTER what it looks like!

Even when the circumstances are saying, "Never."

Even when the bad report says, "it doesn't look good."

Even when the bank account is empty.

Even when your unsaved children look like they want nothing to do with God.

A faithful person keeps looking to Jesus.

A faithful person is not distracted, by the good things happening to others and questioning, "Why does nothing good ever happen for me?"

A faithful person rejoices, strengthens, and encourages themselves in the Lord.

Faithfulness is something you determine and *stick with* in faith! It is the essential key for success in your life. Faithfulness is achieved over time! It's something you do over and over and over again.

Faithfulness requires disciple, and discipline is not a word many like, but it's a *must* to be considered a "faithful person." People want the reward, but many don't want to put any work into it.

It's like going to the gym, if

you are not dedicated and committed to be consistent in your workouts, you can't call yourself faithful; and you will not see the results and benefits from it.

When your feelings are yelling, "just quit, nothing is changing," faithfulness keeps going!

Jesus told us in John 16:33 (AMPC), "...*In the world you have tribulation **and** trials **and** distress **and** frustration...*" A faithful person is not exempt from this, but they take Jesus at His Word when He says, "...*but be of good cheer [take courage; be confident, certain, **undaunted**!] For I have overcome the world. [I have deprived it of power to harm you and have conquered it for you.]*"

Undaunted. That word stood out to me, and it means—"not intimidated or discouraged by difficulty, danger, or disappointment!"

A faithful person is not intimidated or discouraged by difficulty, danger, or disappointment!

James 1:3 (MSG) says, "*You know that under pressure, your faith-life is forced into the open and shows its true colors.*"

You're going to find out what you're made of during those tests, and trials, and tribulations.

BUT the book of James goes

on to say...

James 1:12 (TPT)—"*If your faith remains strong, even while surrounded by life's difficulties...*" ("*when you've stood the test...*" AMPC) and you make that decision to remain strong in your faith, "*you will continue to experience the untold blessings of God!*"

Faith people are not quitters! Settle that once and for all; and say out loud —so you hear yourself say it—"Regardless I will not quit! I will not give up! I will be faithful in the good times and in the difficult times!"

Remember the story of the man in Matthew 25 who gave 3 of his servants 5, 2, and 1 talents... "*each in proportion to his own personal ability*" (AMPC).

The man with the 5 talents doubled his, as did the man with the two talents, but the man with 1 talent said he was afraid of his lord, and decided to do nothing with his talent, but bury it.

The first two heard, "**Well done thy good and FAITHFUL servant.**" They did something with what they had. The man with 1 talent did not hear those words.

I ask you today, *what are **you** doing with your talents?* Are you being faithful with what God has given you—in proportion to your own personal ability?

Do ***all*** you know to do with what **YOU** have!

Colossians 3:23 says, "*put your heart and soul into every activity*

you do as though you are doing it for the Lord."

Don't be concerned with what everyone else has.

How successful they are...

How many followers they have...

How big their church is...

The Lord doesn't reward us because of the size of things in our life, He rewards our faithfulness!

And the end of day, did we do what He told us to do?

I encourage you to be **FAITHFUL WITH WHAT YOU HAVE**, and when you are, Psalm 18:25 (NIV) says, "*To the faithful You [God] show Yourself faithful.*"

That's your promise from the Lord, ***He will show Himself faithful, drenching you liberally with His blessing, His favor, His abundance, and His provision when you remain faithful to Him!***

ZIP IT!

TERRI SAVELLE FOY

One summer a couple of years ago, I was starting to complain about not achieving my goals or seeing progress in certain areas of my life. Just then, the Lord spoke to my heart and said, *"If you're not going to speak faith, don't speak at all."* Wow! God isn't messing around when it comes to just how powerful every word is that comes out of our mouths. In fact, I heard my dad say, "One of the best investments a Christian can make if they want the blessing of God on their lives is a roll of duct tape!" It sounds funny, but the bottom line is if you want to know where your life is headed, listen to the words that are coming out of your mouth.

Proverbs 18:21 says, *"Death and life are in the power of the tongue."* I read that the average person speaks approximately 16,000 words a day. That's the equivalent of filling up a 60-page book every single day. When you comprehend how many words are coming out of your mouth each day, you could think of it like scooping up sand with your hands. In other words, you're not concerned if some of it slips through your fingers. Same with words, right? It's not a big deal if some negative words slip through (out of 16,000 words a day), right?

Let's see what God thinks about that. *"Let me tell you something: Every one of these careless words is going to come back to haunt you. There will be a time of reckoning. Words are powerful; take them seriously. Words can be your salvation. Words can also be your damnation"* (Matthew 12:36-37 MSG).

Your words are carriers of life or death, blessing and cursing. How much could your circumstances dramatically change if you actively spoke God's promises of blessing and increase? Words are vehicles taking you closer to or further from your dreams. Let me ask you this: Are your words limiting you or are they promoting you? Are your words demoralizing and destructive or are they courageous and constructive?

Most people follow the instructions of their doctor when they're told, "This pill will heal you. It will take you from sick to healthy. All you need to do is just follow the instructions. Take the pill." You may not fully understand how it works, but you obey the doctor. Well, the Great Physician said, *"Thou shalt decree a thing, and it shall be established unto thee"* (Job 22:28 KJV). Speaking positive, faith-filled words out of your mouth is the prescription to

live your dreams.

I love how James Clear explains the power of words in his book, *Atomic Habits*. He gives an illustration of two people resisting a cigarette. One person says, "No, thank you. I'm trying to quit." It sounds reasonable and understandable, but it's much more important than most realize. Why? Because this person still sees themselves as a smoker who's trying something. Their identity is a smoker trying to be something else.

The second person declines the cigarette by saying, "No, thanks. I'm not a smoker." This may sound like a minor change, but in reality, it's major! The second person has already decided on a new identity even though they're still in the process of changing. Saying "I'm not a smoker" is a significant change in identity. They're declaring that smoking is a part of their former life not their current identity. You need to do the same thing with your new identity and your dreams.

Change what you're saying, and you'll change what you're seeing. Start declaring, *"I am debt-free. I am successful in everything I set my hands to. I am walking in God's favor every day of my life."* I challenge you to act as if

it's already happened.

Begin talking as if you already have what you're praying for and dreaming about.

I saw a YouTube video the other day of a young teenage boy who is already a millionaire at sixteen. He said that the day he found out his business had just reached \$1 million in revenue, his friend asked, "How does it feel to know that you are officially a millionaire?" He answered, "Exactly like it felt two years ago. I just didn't have the money yet." Why? Because he began speaking the results before he had them. He said, "I was a millionaire before I had the money."

You have to step into the role before you have the results.

Concerning weight loss, people have had amazing results when they did this. Before you've actually lost the weight, walk around as if you've already lost it. Act as if you are the weight you want to be. Would it change the way you eat if you were at your goal weight?

Plain and simple, your words are either closing the door or opening the door to blessings every day. Here's a test to know if what you're saying is helping you or hurting you: practice making this statement after each phrase, "And that's just the way I want it." For example, "No matter what I do, I can't lose weight.... And that's

just the way I want it." Or, "At this rate, I'll be in debt forever... and that's just the way I want it." If it's not the way you want it, then don't let it come out of your mouth!

Let me show you one more important illustration of just how important your words can be. There's a story in the Bible from the first chapter of Luke where an angel appeared to Zechariah and informed him that he and his wife were going to have a baby. Instead of responding with gratitude and enthusiasm, he responded with words of doubt. He questioned the angel by asking, "Are you sure? Do you know how old I am?" I want you to pay close attention to how the angel of the Lord responded to Zechariah's negative words.

"Because you doubted, you will remain silent and not speak until the baby is born." (Luke 1:11-20.) What does that mean?

The angel literally zipped his lips! He shut the guy's mouth and made him unable to speak for nine months! Why? Because he knew that if he let Zechariah speak, he could mess up the whole plan of God for his life.

Think about this in reference to your dreams, being blessed, your doubts, your words. Are you questioning God the way I did when my goals looked completely unattainable? If so, zip it!

"Are you sure? Do you know

how much debt I have?"

"Are you sure? Do you know how unqualified I am?"

"Are you sure? Do you know how many times I've tried to lose weight before?"

"Are you sure? Do you know how old I am?"

What if God zipped your lips today because your mouth was messing up His plans and His ability to pour out more blessings on you? Your dreams could be delayed because of what you're saying. I want you to see that getting your mouth in line with God's promises for your life is a two-step process: **(1) Stop speaking negative, doubt-filled words, and (2) Start speaking positive faith-filled words.**

Activate the blessing of God in your body, family, career, and life by filling your mouth with God's promises for you. Remember, if you're not going to speak faith, don't speak at all. Zip it!

Believers,

do you want to know your Father God more intimately? Be used of Him more, and more powerfully? You are blessed to be a blessing to someone else! Do you realize that as you grow in your faith you are supposed to become just like the man Jesus?

Jesus was sent to show us how to work with *and* under the leading of the Holy Spirit, and to multiply Himself through the believer. As a working example, we see Peter doing just that in Acts 10. Getting Into The Flow of God's Blessing

A few days ago, I walked down to my dock on the Brazos River. I sat down for a little while, just enjoying the peace and watching the river flow. I thought about how the mouth of a river is called its source and it flows down from there. God is our source—He is the source of our blessings, and just like a river, blessings flow down from Him.

Suddenly, I heard the Spirit of God say: “*Show the people how to get into the flow of God’s blessings.*” “*Every good gift and every perfect gift is from **above**, and cometh down from the Father...*” (James 1:17). The Passion Translation says, “*...they stream down from the Father.*” That sounds like a flow, doesn’t it? It sounds a lot like Ezekiel 34:26, “*...I will cause the shower to come down in his season; there shall be showers of blessing.*” That’s why Proverbs 10:6 says, “*Blessings are upon the **head** of the just...*”

That’s a streamflow—showers of blessing. There are some seasons we get very little rain, some seasons like springtime we get an abundance of rain: but there’s always a *continual* flow. Blessings should never *cease*. God is not interested in you being blessed occasionally; He wants you blessed all the time with a steady flow of His blessings!

How much of the flow of God’s blessings do you want in your life? Ezekiel 47:1-5 describes a flowing river that you could get into up

to your ankles, your knees, your loins, or you could get in at a level that was over your head, in all the way.

You’ve got a choice. I don’t know about you, but I want in over my head! I want in all the way! I want everything God has for me!

A FAITHFUL MAN GETS INTO THE FLOW.

Proverbs 20:6 says ...*who can find a faithful man?*” (NKJV). When the Bible has to ask that question, then it’s a serious problem in the body of Christ. God wants ALL of His people to experience ALL of His blessings—He’s no respecter of persons. But, there is a part that you and I play, and that part is faithfulness.

People have different opinions about what faithfulness is. My definition of faithfulness is to become unwavering, uncompromising, and resolute regarding what God has said and how God expects us to live. I want you to notice a key word in Psalms 92:12-14 (AMPC); that word is *uncompromisingly*.

“¹²The [*uncompromisingly*] righteous shall flourish like the palm tree [be long-lived, stately, upright, useful, and fruitful]; they shall grow like a cedar in Lebanon [majestic, stable, durable, and incorruptible].¹³Planted in the house of the Lord, they shall flourish in the courts of our God.”¹⁴[Growing in grace] **they shall still bring forth**

fruit in old age; they shall be full of sap [of spiritual vitality] and [rich in the] verdure [of trust, love, and contentment].”

FAITHFULNESS TO GOD AND TO HIS WORD ARE HOW WE GET INTO THE FLOW.

Getting into the flow of God’s blessings is directly linked to how faithful you are to incorporate God’s principles for living into your lifestyle. Everyone would like to get into the flow but not everyone will **because they aren’t faithful**. Faithfulness requires discipline, and discipline is an ugly word to most Christians.

“*And it shall come to pass, if thou shalt hearken **diligently** unto the voice of the Lord thy God, to observe and to **do** all his commandments which I command thee this day, that the Lord thy God will set thee on high above all nations of the earth: ²**And all these blessings shall come on thee, and overtake thee, if thou shalt hearken unto the voice of the Lord thy God***” (Deuteronomy 28:1-2 KJV)

“...All these blessings will come down on you and spread out beyond you because you have responded to the Voice of God, your God” (Deuteronomy 28:2 MSG) The NIV says, “All these blessings will come on you and **accompany** you if you obey

the Lord your God."

The blessings will come on you and overtake you, then they will come down and spread out beyond you, and finally, they will come on you and *accompany* you... be present with you wherever you go and in whatever you do.

Say this: "I intend to obey the Lord, my God, therefore; all these blessings will be mine!"

Faithfulness is the major key. The Apostle Paul said in 1st Timothy 1:12 (KJV), "*And I thank Christ Jesus our Lord, who hath enabled me, for that he counted me faithful...*" Counted is deemed, considered, or judged. So, Paul is saying, "God took a survey of my life and discovered and pronounced that I was faithful."

The supreme test is not you asking yourself if you are faithful, but God. If God was to investigate your life today, would He determine and pronounce you faithful?

A lot of people are faithful until there's a crisis. They stop being faithful when adversity comes—they blame God saying— "Why did God let this happen to me?" They stop giving. Then they stop going to church. On the other hand, there are people that are faithful in a crisis but when things are

easy, they begin doing things their way or feel like they don't need God anymore. Determine right now that no matter what happens from now on that you will remain faithful in the good times as well as in the bad times. Get in the flow all the way and stay there!

Sometimes when you're experiencing your worst circumstances, God will tell you to do something that doesn't seem reasonable, but if you obey it will put you in a flow. When you think, "I can't afford to give," God has told you to give. If you're obedient it will break a barrier. God is never trying to take something from you, He's trying to get something to you.

Proverbs 28:20 (KJV) says, "*A faithful man shall abound with blessings...*" Abound means that the blessings will be in great abundance and prevalent; not only you will know it, but others will know it. Your faithfulness is visible; others can see it.

The Passion Translation of Proverbs 28:20 says, "*Life's blessings drench the honest and faithful person...*" Drench means to cover, submerge, and permeate. Permeate implies freely flowing.

**SO, LIFE'S BLESSINGS

"*A faithful person will be richly blessed...*" (Proverbs 28:20 NIV). When you've determined that this is how you will live, then get ready, because the blessings will flow! Being faithful is something you must determine to be, and then stick with it in the good times and

in the bad times. It is a decision, a lifestyle...every day.

**FAITHFULNESS ALWAYS
GETS GOD'S ATTENTION.**

Once Jesus was sharing a parable with His disciples—He told them about faithful servants and what the master said to them. In Matthew 25:21 The Passion Translation says, "*...You have done well, and proven yourself to be my loyal and trustworthy servant. Because you have been a faithful steward...I will put you in charge of much, much more...*" I call that getting in the flow!

Are you practicing what you've seen in the Word? Are people noticing it? The evidence of your faithfulness to God and His Word will stand out to others. In 1st Thessalonians 1:8 (KJV), Paul says to the Thessalonian believers, "*...in every place your faith to God-ward is spread abroad...*" The Amplified Bible Classic Edition says, "*everywhere the report has gone forth of your faith in God.*" The Message Translation adds this, "*your lives are echoing the Master's word... all over the place.*"

Somebody else should notice your faithfulness—not only your faith in God but your faithfulness to God. It's one thing to believe in God, but it's another thing to be faithful to God. Faithfulness requires us to move beyond ourselves and to put the will of God first place in our lives. The greatest example of faithfulness is in the life and ministry of Jesus Himself. Even when He was about to be taken to the cross to be crucified, He said, "*Father, if thou be willing, remove this cup from*

me: nevertheless not my will, but thine, be done" (Luke 22:42 KJV). That's true faithfulness! The life of faithfulness is not always an easy life, but it is a rewarding life.

CONSISTENCY IS A KEY FACTOR IN ENTERING INTO THE FLOW.

The Bible says we have a better covenant founded upon better promises than the people in the Old Testament. Abraham was blessed and favored. Under the New Testament—YOU are extremely blessed and highly favored—that's a BETTER covenant.

Consistently acting on the Word is a requirement in the New Testament. James 1:22 says, *"But be ye doers of the Word, and not hearers only, deceiving your own selves."* In other words, if you're not a **doer** of the Word, then you're deceived. This is not implying doing the Word occasionally, it's consistently being a doer of the Word.

The Amplified Bible Classic Edition says, *"...be doers of the Word [obey the message], and not merely listeners to it..."* And The Message Translation says, *"Act on what you hear!"* You are responsible to act on what you hear.

James 1:25 says, *"...a doer of the work, this man shall be blessed in his deed."* The Amplified (AMP) translation says, *"But he who looks carefully into the perfect law, the **law of liberty**, and **faithfully** abides by it, not having become a [careless] listener who forgets but an*

active doer [who obeys], he will be blessed and favored by God in what he does [in his life of obedience]." Live consistently on the principles of God's Word and you will be blessed in your deeds.

I've had people say, "What am I doing wrong? I'm under attack?" I tell them it's not always something you're doing wrong. Sometimes, it's because you're doing something right!

Jesus said, in the world you will have tribulation, but be of good cheer, I have overcome the world. While you're in this world, you will be faced with adversity, but that doesn't mean you have to give up and quit. Jesus has conquered it for you! If you are determined to endure, then He will deliver you!

Satan will not be able to stop the flow of God's blessings in your life. Paul said in 2nd Thessalonians 3:3, *"...the Lord is faithful, and He will strengthen [you] and set you on a firm foundation and guard you from the evil [one]"* (AMPC). The Message Translation says, *"...the Master never lets us down. He will stick by you and protect you from evil."*

"...Continue to hold to the things that you have learned and of which you are convinced..." (2 Timothy 3:14 AMPC). Don't change a thing—remain faithful, remain committed, and God will see you through.

No matter what I might be going through, I believe that somehow, someday I *am* going to see the goodness of God—it's going to manifest in my life, and it will manifest right on time!

Make a quality decision and don't back off or turn back; decide to remain faithful and consistent no matter what's going on. This will keep you in the flow of God's blessings!

Every once in a while, if you are feeling down say this, "I'm in the flow! Blessings are coming my way—when I'm coming in and when I'm going out, when I'm in the city and when I'm in the field. Blessings hunt me down—they come on me, overtake me and surprise me, because I'm in the flow!"

Say this prayer with me: ***Thank you Father for your goodness and mercy, and thank you for enabling me to be committed, to be faithful to your Word, and to experience the flow of your blessings.***

Wakan Najin Sizi

Standing Holy
The Honor Of A Name

It is said amongst our Tribes of Turtle Island, the North Americas, that when you receive the bestowment of a name, you are only given a name when you have accomplished a great, special achievement in life.

Our elders, as in the days of old, would pray and receive a name from the Spirit that is specific to that person and they are so named for their character, what they stand for in life, and what they are doing in life or have accomplished in life. There are songs sung, gifts given, words are spoken, and a declaration of the name to the four corners of the earth and throughout the heavens declaring to the north, east, south, and west making it known to the world and releasing the sound of that name. During this special ceremony it is also important for the receiver of the name to give gifts to the witnesses there, and Wakan Najin Sizí, Dr. Jerry Savelle, delivered the best gift that could be given which is the delivering of the Word of God to the people. It was a holy, sacred moment.

So, to this one, Jerry Savelle, the honor of a name has been given and is Wakan Najin Sizí, Standing Holy. Pronounced in Lakota - wa-ka nazhee with a nasal sound on the latter half of the waka and in Navajo Sizí, pronounced si-zí with a nasal sound and greater emphasis on the latter half of the “zí”.

It has great strength and has a far deeper meaning than what is translated in the English language. For in Lakota and the Navajo language it represents so much more than just Standing Holy. The name Wakan in Lakota is actually a part of God's name in the Lakota Language which is Wakan Tanka and Wakan represents everything that God is. Najin Sizí is the meaning of standing within something but standing strong or standing in something that encompasses you and when you place those two words together it means, “One who stands firm in everything the Great Spirit is and represents.” So, it could read as, “This one, Wakan Najin Sizí, stands firm in the Lord's holiness, stands in His favor, in His goodness, blessing and all that God truly represents.”

So, with our love for Brother Jerry, this name was given after the likeness of our Heavenly Father, Who has bestowed upon us the greatest Name of all time, which is His very Name through our Lord and Savior Jesus Christ and now we are a part of His great and wonderful family.

Now today through receiving this great honor, Wakan Najin Sizí, has become one of us as Indigenous and has been received into the Tribes of the Lakota Nation and the Navajo Nation. To the world he is known as Dr. Jerry Savelle, but to our Indigenous People he shall be known as Wakan Najin Sizí, Standing Holy. This is one of the greatest honors we could bestow upon him as Indigenous People, and most of all because we love him.

This name was released during the Healing of the Nations Motorcycle Rally at the Navajo Nation in Arizona in the year 2022 in the month of August.
