The word I received from the Lord for 2023 was, "Tell the people that this will be a year for the maximum—the highest level attainable." I am already seeing this come to pass in my own life. In fact, I didn't wait for 2023 to get here. As soon as I heard it, I received what God said and began expecting it and starting seeing results immediately!

It matters whether or not you believe that this will happen in your life. The Bible says in Hebrews 4 that the Word did not profit them because they did not mix faith with it when they heard it. So, it's vitally important that you mix your faith with this word if you want it to come to pass in your life.

The Lord said to me, "Tell the people what they do FIRST is a vital key to living in the maximum in 2023."

WHAT YOU DO FIRST ALWAYS MATTERS TO GOD!

There are certain things that I don't like to do, but I know that I need to do them if I want success... and I want success. I'm not in this to fail. I'm in this to see what God has promised me come to pass and to give Him honor for it as it happens.

I read a book a long time ago by Albert E.N. Gray titled *The Common Denominator of Success*, and it made an impact on me. Mr. Gray was an official of the Prudential Insurance Company of America. He spent his life searching for the one trait that all successful people share. His book was released back in 1940, and it revealed that successful people's common characteristic was not just hard work, even though that is important, but the one that seemed to transcend all the rest was *the habit of putting first things first*.

He observed that the successful person has the habit of doing what failures don't like to do. Even though successful people often don't like to do them either, their disliking of doing them is subordinate to the strength of their purpose. And their purpose is to fulfill their goals—to see maximum results.

He said that every single qualification for success is acquired through *habit*. The habit of doing what other people don't like doing—the habit of **putting first** things first.

God has been telling us that in His Word for a very long time!

Haggai 1:2-7 communicates the same message that this gentleman wrote about. "Thus speaketh the Lord of hosts, saying, 'This people say, The time is not come, the time that the Lord's house should be built.' Then came the word of the Lord by Haggai the prophet, saying, 'Is it time for you, O ye, to dwell in your cieled houses, and this house

lie waste? ⁵Now therefore thus saith the Lord of hosts; 'Consider your ways.' ⁶Ye have sown much, and bring in little; ye eat, but ye have not enough; ye drink, but ye are not filled with drink; ye clothe you, but there is none warm; and he that earneth wages earneth wages to put it into a bag with holes. ⁷Thus saith the Lord of hosts; Consider your ways."

CONSIDER YOUR WAYS!

Here we find that the people had begun to drift away from God, and they lived with misplaced priorities. Haggai was sent to these people to help get their priorities back in line with where they should have been and what would have been pleasing to God. Twice he made that statement: "consider your ways." He's saying, "the reason you're here is because of your ways."

It's never God's way that prevents us from experiencing His best, it's always our way. The Message translation says, "Take a good, hard look at your life. Think it over." He tells them "this is your condition because of your ways."

A lot of Christians are that way today. They want to succeed, yet they live with misplaced priorities. God wants you to succeed, but you can't put success ahead of your love for God and your seeking God.

If things are not working the way they should according to God's Word, knowing there is nothing wrong with God's Word, there's nothing wrong with God, there's nothing wrong with the Holy Spirit, and nothing wrong with Jesus... did I leave anybody out? It may be you! In fact, it is you.

HAGGAI'S MESSAGE TO THE PEOPLE WAS PUT FIRST THINGS FIRST.

Compass

The temple was destroyed by the Babylonian empire seventy years earlier and God had given the people the task of rebuilding the temple, but they kept putting it off. Instead, they built their own good houses and they left the House of God in ruin, even though He had given them this assignment—rebuild the temple.

They kept saying, "It's not they went about time." So, pursuing their own dreams, their own desires, and their own wants, and left the House of God in ruin. As a result, they suffered for their procrastination, and for their misplaced priorities. They were not experiencing the maximum and they were not experiencing highest attainable. the level

For the **temple** to lie in ruins was not only an indication that they were prone to procrastination, but it also indicated a neglect in worshiping God, because the temple in those days was where you worshipped God.

I've discovered and observed over the years that when you get sloppy in some things, you also get sloppy in your relationship with God. If you get sloppy in the mundane things, the things you do every day, you usually get sloppy in your relationship with God as well. This is what they did, and it manifested in their relationship with God as well.

I Corinthians 10:11-12 in The Message translation says, "These are all warning markers—DANGER! ...written down so that we don't repeat their mistakes." The reason that we have this account in the book of Haggai is for our benefit so that we don't repeat their mistakes.





5 BIBICAL PRINCIPLES FROM THE BOOK OF HAGGAI:

- **1** Stop making excuses for not putting first things FIRST.
- **2** Stop being selfish (thinking only of your wants and your desires).
- Take a good look at where you have put the things of God in your list of priorities.
- Stop being the reason that your blessings are being blocked.
- Let God hold the highest place in your life now and forever.

Deuteronomy 6:5 from The Message translation says, "Love God, your God, with your whole heart: love Him with all that's in you, love Him with all you've got!" Our greatest love, and our deepest affection, should be directed toward God.

God told Abraham the father of faith in Genesis 17:1 (AMPC) "walk and live habitually before Me..." Meaning—unending, unceasing, not seasonal, not just when everything is going well, but always—habitually.

Jesus made this statement in John 14:15, "If ye love Me, keep My commandments." The Message translation says, "If you love Me, show it by doing what I've told you." In other words, He's saying, "I want more than just words. I appreciate you saying, 'I love you,' but I want you to show Me by doing what I've told you."

One of the major things that Jesus told us is found in Matthew 6:33 (AMPC) "But seek (aim at and strive after) first of all His kingdom and His righteousness (His way of doing and being right)..." He's saying, "If you love Me, then do what I say, do what I've told you, and what I'm telling you is this, seek (aim at and strive after) first of all My kingdom and My righteousness—My way of doing and being right."

Some definitions of the word first are "in the foremost place, *the highest* or greatest of importance, ranking above all else, prominent."

SAY THIS ALOUD:

"My first priority is to seek God, His Kingdom, His Righteousness, His Way of doing, and His Way of being right."

Now if you're going to do that, then obviously you're going to have to spend some time in the Word to find out what it says about His way of doing things. The Bible says "there is a way that seems right, but the end thereof is destruction." I always like to say, "If there is a way that seems right, then there is a way that seems right, then there is a way that IS right." And that's God's way.

How can you know God's way? The Bible. It says in the book of Hebrews that Jesus perfectly expressed the *will*, the *nature*, and the *character* of God. So, if you want to see how God does things, then follow the ministry of Jesus.

There was a slogan years ago that was very popular, "What Would Jesus Do" (WWJD). That's still a good plan.

WHAT WOULD JESUS DO TO EXPERIENCE THE MAXIMUM AND THE HIGHEST LEVEL ATTAINABLE?

Jesus made this statement in Matthew 13:3, "Behold, a sower went forth to sow..." That's what sowers do. They sow. If you are sower then sowing should be just as normal to you as breathing.

So WHO is in charge of your harvest? YOU ARE. We plant, but it's God who gives the increase. But we determine the *kind* and *size* of the increase by the seeds we sow and *how* we sow them.

What farmer goes to the field and says, "give me a harvest and I'll plant some seed." That's backwards. You have to sow FIRST. Galatians 6:9 says, "And let us not be weary in well doing: for in due season we shall reap, if we faint not." The "well doing" he's talking about is sowing, that's the theme in Galatians 6. The Message translation says, "if we don't give up, or quit."

If we wait for the conditions to be perfect, Satan will see to it the conditions are never perfect. My greatest harvests have been the result of my sowing when the conditions weren't perfect. It's easy to sow when the conditions are perfect; it takes faith to sow when the conditions are not perfect. It takes faith to sow when in the natural it doesn't look like it's the time to sow.

We have an example of this in First Kings chapter 17. God spoke to the prophet Elijah, 'Arise, get thee to Zarephath ...and dwell there: behold, I have commanded a widow woman there to sustain thee.' Notice that phrase, "sustain thee." She's going to do something for him that will sustain him, but what God told her to do also sustained her and her son. "And Elijah said unto her, Fear not; go

and do as thou hast said: but make me thereof a little cake first..."

She gave up the certain for the uncertain, and "she went and did according to the saying of Elijah," even though it did not look in the natural like the time to sow. Her willingness to obey God opened the door to the supernatural. Those may be the most important words in that story, "she went and did." She made him a little cake first.

WHAT YOU DO FIRST, MATTERS TO GOD.

What you do FIRST determines whether or not you experience the maximum and the highest level attainable.

I just shared with you God's

way of doing and being right.

In Haggai 1:2-7, after he had given them the word of the Lord, to "consider their ways," the Bible says in verse 14, "and they came and did work in the house of the Lord of hosts, their God."

They got stirred up about doing *first things first*, and they went and did just like the little woman we read about in First Kings 17—they got busy rebuilding and restoring the temple, and God said, "**from this day I will bless you**" (Haggai 2:19)

GO AND DO FIRST THINGS FIRST AND SEE THE RESULTS OF DOING THINGS GOD'S WAY. I believe God is going to take you to the maximum, to the highest level attainable in the name of Jesus!

We are living in very challenging times. It's by Faith that we will prosper, it's by faith that we will see the maximum in our lives; it's by faith that we will reach the highest level attainable.

It's going to take aggressive faith for a person to prosper in these times.

Hebrews 11:1-34 lists our patriarchs of faith. By faith Abraham (verse 17), **by faith** Isaac (v. 20), by faith Joseph (v. 22). By faith Moses (v. 23), by faith he forsook Egypt (v. 27), through faith he kept the Passover and the sprinkling of blood (v. 23), by faith they [God's people] passed through the Red Sea (v. 29). By faith the walls of Jericho fell (v. 30). A whole list of people who by faith "subdued kingdoms, wrought righteousness obtained promises, and stopped the mouths of lions" (v. 32).

Faith is an aggressive force. In the Greek *pistis* means "an aggressive, forward-directed force, never passive; never retreating, backward or shy."

In First Samuel 17:48, David *ran toward* the army to meet the Philistine *by faith*.

The word from the Lord from brother Jerry for 2023 is the year of the maximum and the highest level attainable. We must *run toward* this word, being determined, persistent, aggressive, *and* believing it will come to pass in our lives.

Faith refuses to give up and quit; it won't let go of the Word of God that's been given.

"Now faith is the substance of things hoped for, the evidence of things not seen. ²For by it the elders obtained good report. ³Through faith we understand that the worlds were framed by the Word of God, so that things which are seen were not made of things which do appear." Hebrews 11:1-3

Faith aggressively takes what belongs to it, "Therefore I say to you, What things soever you desire, when you pray, believe that you receive [you take] them, and you shall have them" (Mark 11:24).

The Greek *lambanō* means to *take* (in a prolonged form) what is one's own or to make one's own, with much force; seize with a grip that cannot be shaken off and when taken is not let go, to appropriate to one's self; to take a thing due (Strong's G2983).

What God has so wonderfully provided through His grace, we must lay hold of, possess, and take with our faith. "How long are you slack to go to possess [yāraš: seize, to inherit it, occupy it] the land which the Lord God of your fathers has given you?" (Joshua 18:3; Strong's H3423).

The only way we obtain the maximum and the highest level attainable is to possess it, claim it, confess it, say that it's ours. We have to do this on a daily basis — continually declaring the Word of the Lord, that it belongs to us.

The NLT says, "How long are you going to wait before taking



possession of the remaining land that God has given you? "The Message says, "How long are you going to sit around on your hands and put off taking possession of the land that God, the God of your ancestors, has given you?"

Aggressive Faith seizes the maximum and the highest level attainable; it makes a demand on God's Word and takes hold of the desired result.

In Romans 12:2, we are urged, "Do not be conformed to this world but be transformed by the renewing of your mind." The attack on your mind might be crippling at moments.

How can we make it during

these hard times? THE MESSAGE translation says, "Don't become so well-adjusted to your culture that you fit into it without even thinking." The Phillips translation says, "Don't let the world around you squeeze you into its mold." Isaiah 26:3 says, "Thou wilt keep him in perfect peace, whose mind is stayed on Thee; because he trusted in Thee."

A total-selling out, a total dedication, consecration and commitment to the Lord is required. You have to declare every day that My God is working in me, working in everything around me for my

favor, best interest, and that I will receive the maximum and the highest level attainable in this life!

I am sharing with you how I have done this for over 41 years. It will work for you if you follow His steps.

Now may the God of peace **Himself** sanctify you through

and through [that is, separate you from profane and vulgar things, make you pure and whole and undamaged—consecrated to Him—set apart for His purpose]; and may your spirit and soul and body be kept complete and [be found] blameless at the coming of our Lord Jesus Christ" (1st Thessalonians 5:23).

We're spirit, soul, and body, and that is the divine order. We should come first *from* the spirit, *through* the mind and *to* the body;

that's how it's *supposed* to be. This is why I start my day with music that feeds my spirit, renews my mind, and strengthens my body. I remind myself who I am and bind whatever spirits are coming against me. I get the environment ready to hear from my God in His presence.

There are three steps I always take to position myself to hear from God. I know and declare my steps are ordered by the Lord. He goes before me, and I **follow**.

I don't go anywhere God has not gone first ahead of me. I do things His way. This is the same for every area of life in spirit, soul, and body:

Believe

Go to God in faith, believing.

Obey

Do what God says to me *or* in the Word of God, the Bible.

Pray

Seek God.

Hear from God

Write it down.

A lot of people are not sure how to hear from God. Let God show you where you are weak and need His Word (the Bible), and His direction (leading of the Holy Spirit). Habakkuk 2:1-4 tells us to watch to see what God will say to us, but He said that He will answer us. We are to write it down so we can run with it. He adds Himself (strength) where we are weak. Find out what His part is and what your part is. Listen and get details and write it down.

God will lead you. He will go before you and prepare your way. Remember you are the righteousness of God through Jesus. You are God's and He will fight your battle. Stay in His ways "and it will come to pass, IF thou shalt hearken diligently

unto the voice of the LORD thy God, to observe and to do all His commandments which I command thee this day (today), that the LORD thy God will set thee on high above all nations of the earth: AND all these blessings shall; come on thee, and overtake thee (the maximum), IF thou shalt hearken unto the voice of the LORD thy God" (Deuteronomy 28:1-2).

When I see the word "blessings" in Deuteronomy 28:1-2 for example, I read it as spirit, soul, and body... blessed in spirit, blessed in soul, and blessed in body. I do that for each thing in the Word.

You can have, "all these blessings will come upon you and overtake you" because He is your God, and you heard Him, and did what He said to you. The supernatural is God's part (super) plus your part (natural). You can live and operate in the supernatural.

When you want to achieve the maximum level, first you have to decide *in* what—*finances*, *health*, *deliverance*? Get the plan from God and do His steps one at a time. It takes obedience to reach maximum-level results. If you miss it along the way, you will get a lower percentage return. If you want the maximum return, you have to do it the way God says. There are conditions involved.

At first, for me, it was debt. The first time I ever heard the Lord tell me to do something, it was "Get

out of debt!" He told me, "You have to use My Scriptures to do it." Acting in faith and obedience, I got Philippians 4:19, "for my God shall supply all my need according to His riches in glory through Christ Jesus." My God shall supply all my spirit needs; my God shall supply all my soul needs; my God shall supply all my body needs.

At that time I was not in riches, but He's *giving* me riches. I know He's blessed me because He **says** He has. I **believe** what God said, and He said the just will live by faith. Well you better!

It will take faith to conquer any stronghold in your life.

My part of things is **faith** with actions. So far, the only thing I'd heard from Him at that point was, "Get out of debt. I want you out of debt before you go to work for Brother Jerry." I did not know how it would happen, but He's already said He'll provide it ... so my part is faith: believe, obey, and pray (spirit, soul and body).

In the natural, there was no way it was going to happen. My paychecks were already going to bills. He said, "I'll provide it for you with nothing coming out of your salary." The steps of a good man, woman, or child are ordered by the Lord; so I had to listen and do His steps.

There will almost always be steps. I followed His instructions.

I used my paychecks just like before, and if I had any extra, I paid it on my debt. Anything extra that came in (not my salary) I knew was to go toward my debt. I got a call one day soon after that. There was a company in another city nearby that needed my expertise. All I had to do was drive to the location and be there with their guys. They did the work; I was just there to oversee it and make sure it was done legally. The project took five minutes, and I left. I did it to help them out. I didn't expect to get anything from it.

About two weeks later, I got a check in the mail from a law firm for \$2,000, unexpected money, not my salary. God was doing His part, and I was doing mine. I realized that's how He was working when the money came. I paid off a debt. I was obedient, and that opened up the next step.

I stayed with God. If I made a sale in my business that went above the regular price I used the profit to pay debts or if I brought something into my shop and got four times the investment out of it, the Lord said, "I just did it again, pay it on your debt."...and within six months I was debt free. We had never been debt free, and within six more months I had a large bank account ready so I could go to work for Brother Jerry.

Getting out of debt was the area I needed help in the most, and He showed me how to do it. I call it the three W's: what, where, and when.

The Three W's:

- **What**does He want you to do?
- 2 When does He want you to do it?
- 3 Where does he want you to do it?

If you miss one of those W's, you'll have part of the return, but you'll never have 100% (the maximum) without doing them ALL. This teaching has worked all over the world, and it will work for you IF you DO God's what, when and where the way He tells you.

It's time for the Maximum! God has a good plan for your life. God wants you to experience maximum results. Follow His steps to move from where you are to maximum level—spirit, soul, and body.

as he walked away that day from having a conversation with Jesus. Did he replay the conversation in his mind? Did he contemplate and wonder why it didn't come out the way he rehearsed it? Have you been there before?


You enter into a conversation, and you were expecting it to go one way, but at the end of the conversation it didn't turn out as you had anticipated.

I believe this is what happened when this rich young ruler came to yet on the inside there was so much more going on. His heart was crying out for more, but he could not go "ALL IN."

Jesus' In conversation afterward with His disciples, He told them that when you go "ALL IN" it sets you up for hundredfold return in this life, the Highest Level attainable. That's where we are going this year as we choose an "ALL IN" life.

Dr. Savelle recently made a statement that continues to resonate in my heart—"ALL I your heart? Father, I am ALL IN!

I believe when Jesus had the conversation with that young man that day, He wasn't teaching something that was just a good idea. He was teaching and modeling His life's journey. I believe Jesus was teaching His journey and how He had come to a place where He had left all. He knew that leaving all was difficult and challenging, but He also knew that leaving all would cause Him to live a life at another level... THE Highest Level.



used throughout His earthly ministry; it wasn't complicated and it wasn't deep. It's just this two-word phrase—"Follow Me." I believe it's ultimately what Jesus was saying to that young man, and what He was communicating to the disciples. He was saying "follow My example." Jesus operated in the maximum and lived on another level, not because He was Jesus, but because of His heart to submit to the Father, to go ALL IN.

I believe our greatest victories and our greatest defeats can come down to *who* and *what* we're submitted to. The word submission is not a word that we like, but it's a word that will bring about extraordinary results. It means "to arrange under, to be subject to one's control, to yield to one's advice, and to obey."

"The Calling on your life is great, but it is in submitting to THE ONE that called you that makes you great!"

Jesus operated in the maximum and on another level because He brought *Himself* into **total submission**. He taught it *and* He modeled it throughout His life.

John 5:19 "I say to you, the Son can do nothing of Himself, but what He sees the Father do."

John 5:30 "I can of Myself do nothing—I do not seek My own will but the will of the Father who sent Me."

John 6:38 "I have come down from heaven not do My own will, but the will of Him that sent Me."

John 14:10 "Do you not believe that I am in the Father, and the Father is in Me?...the Father who dwells in Me does the works."

JESUS WAS ALL IN.

Everywhere Jesus went He operated on a greater level because He walked in great submission. When you submit, or go ALL IN, there is an exchange: our weakness for His strength, our natural for His supernatural.

In Philippians 2:6-9, Paul tells us this about Jesus—"being in the form of God, did not consider it robbery to be equal with God, but made Himself of no reputation, taking the form of a bondservant." This tells me that Jesus was a servant by choice, not because He had to. A bondservant is one that made a decision to be ALL IN to his master. Paul goes on to say that as a result of Jesus doing this,

"Therefore God also has highly exalted Him and given Him the name which is above every name." "For to this you were called, because Christ also suffered for us, leaving us an example, that you should follow His steps:

He committed no sin nor was deceit found in His mouth;

Who, when He was reviled, did not revile in return;

When He suffered, He did not threaten, but Committed Himself to Him who judges righteously" (1 Peter 2:21-23).

Peter is telling us to follow His steps. Jesus was not committed to sin, meaning He was not letting His *flesh* rule Him, but **He was committed to God**.

HE was ALL IN when it came to following the Father. His focus was always on the Father, and it was through that submission that He did great things!

Jesus modeled this ALL IN Life.

He was ALL IN when it came to God's Word. He was ALL IN when it came to His prayer



life. He was ALL IN submitted to the Father in every way.

John 14:30-31 says, "I will no longer talk much with you, for the ruler of this world is coming, and he has nothing in Me. But that the world may know that I love the Father, and as the Father gave Me commandment, so I do. Arise, let us go from here." The ruler of this world had nothing in Him because Jesus was totally submitted to and surrendered to the Father.

In John's writings here we see the heart behind everything that Jesus did was in the phrase "that the world may know that I love the Father." Jesus was *ALL IN*—this was not something He just taught; HE LIVED IT. When we look at His life, we can see the maximum. The miracles flowed through His life and ministry because He was *ALL IN*. He had great provision because He was *ALL IN*, and the enemy could not touch Him.

For the rest of 2023 **Go** *ALL IN!!!* Make a determined decision to heed the instruction that Jesus gave to the rich young ruler, "FOLLOW ME." Be a servant as Jesus was. Commit yourself to Him who judges righteously and say like Jesus said, "the God of this world has nothing in Me because I love the Father." As this becomes our life's pursuit, we *will* see the MAXIMUM in our lives!



What we do *first* matters to God. I like knowing that God is always a step ahead of us. God never misses it. He's already thinking about rewarding your obedience. He has good thoughts and plans for your life (Jeremiah 29:11).

What are you willing to do to ensure that your 2023 will be a year for the maximum and the highest level attainable?

You express the genuineness of your faith through your *actions*. It's not enough just to talk it. It's not enough for us to just go around saying, "This is my year for the maximum and the highest level attainable." That's the *starting* point, you need to be talking it, but without "[good] works" (corresponding actions), the Bible says your faith is void of power (James 2:20 AMPC).

Faith is proved by corresponding actions; it's not just words out of your mouth. Faith speaks, but faith without [good] corresponding actions is void of power (inactive, ineffective, and worthless). Genuine faith takes action!

This is your opportunity to "GO and DO!"

James 2:22 shows us how Abraham (the Father of faith) reached the maximum in his faith; "Seest thou how faith wrought with his [good] works..." There's another translation that changes the word "works" to "corresponding actions." His faith reached its supreme expression when he

implemented his faith by his corresponding actions.

I'm going to use that phrase "corresponding actions" when I see the word "works." I don't want you to think that doing "good works" is going to give you points with God. Don't be confused. That's not what we're talking about here—it's a consistent life of faith with good corresponding actions.

Abraham is an example of the life of faith that gets maximum results. "Was not Abraham our father justified by corresponding actions, when he had offered Isaac his son upon the altar?" (James 2:21).

God had already told Abraham that he was going to be the Father of many nations. And you know at a later point, God asked him to offer his only son Isaac, and without any hesitation, Abraham took his son to the mountain where God had told him to offer him, and when they were on the way up the mountain, Isaac asked, 'Father we have the fire, we have the wood, where's the lamb?'

It is apparent Isaac was familiar with his father offering sacrifices, because he knew what was required—the fire, the wood, and the lamb. Abraham said to him, 'My son, God will provide.' And he kept right on walking toward the place where he would offer him for sacrifice; I believe

we can all agree that was good corresponding actions.

They went on up the mountain and built the altar, like usual. This time, Abraham told his son to get on the altar. He strapped him to it and raised his knife, prepared to slay him in faith, because he had already been told by God that *this seed* will produce a mighty nation, and dead boys can't produce mighty nations.

The book of Hebrews says that Abraham saw this in a figure or a vision. He saw it before it ever happened. That's the reason why he did not hesitate, even though he had just let go of Ishmael in Genesis 21 right before he got his instructions from God to sacrifice Isaac.

Just going around saying, "I'm going to be the father of many nations," was not enough—that was only the starting point. There had to be corresponding actions, and Abraham walked in faith with corresponding actions all the way to the manifestation, to the highest level attainable, and he received maximum results.

How do you put your corresponding actions with saying this will be the year of the maximum and the highest level attainable?

... By sowing seed toward it.

It will be the year of the maximum and the highest level attainable—that's what I'm believing, that's what I'm expecting, that's what I'm talking ...and I've got my corresponding actions lining up with it as well.

For every major miracle and breakthrough in the Bible, there was always a seed sown first before the miracle or the breakthrough came.

For instance, the woman with the issue of blood—under Levitical law, with that issue of blood, she was not allowed to go into a crowd with that disease. So, her seed was her very life. She was willing to lay her life on the line. That was her seed. And the Bible says, "and her faith made her whole." Notice it was her faith and corresponding actions.

The Bible says, "when she heard that Jesus was in her village, she said, 'I will but touch his clothes and I shall be made whole.' That was her faith confession, but she didn't stay home and just repeat, "If I get to touch his clothes, I will be made whole."

She went and did. She added corresponding actions to her confession of faith. She sowed her seed—her very life. She very easily could have been stoned. The Bible says Jesus told her, "Daughter, YOUR faith has made you whole."

Her faith reached supreme expression. Confession alone is not enough—that's the starting point, but if you want your faith to reach supreme expression, there *must* be corresponding actions.

There was a seed sown where Jairus was concerned as well, in the same story. Remember he came to Jesus *first*, before the woman with the issue of blood. In Mark 5:23 he said, "*My little daughter lieth at the point of death*." Jesus said, "*I'll come and heal her*."

Now at that time Jesus was not the most popular figure among religious people. And the ruler of the synagogue, Jairus, said to him, "come lay your hands on my little daughter that she might be healed." Jesus started in that direction and then this woman stopped him by reaching out and touching His clothes. Jesus turned and said, "Who touched Me?"

It touches God when we come in this kind of supreme expression of faith.

The Bible indicates there was a crowd of people. The disciples were amazed at His question. They said, "People are all around You touching You." One translation I read says, "No this was a different touch, it was the touch of faith. Someone has made a demand on My ability."

When she touched Jesus' garment, it stopped Him. When He turned, He saw the woman and she was fearing and trembling because when Jesus brought attention to her, she knew that the man He was walking with, Jairus, was the one who could give the orders for her to be stoned. As one of the Board of Elders, a ruler at the synagogue in Capernaum, he knew her issue

and that she was unclean under the law. Jairus had to turn around and see why Jesus stopped; she had interrupted His miracle, but her faith had made her whole.

In the midst of all of this, a messenger came and said to Jairus, "Don't trouble the Master any longer, your daughter is dead." Jesus turned and said, "Fear not. Only believe." I read one paraphrase years ago and it said that Jesus turned to Jairus and said, "Fear not. I'll take care of this. I'll be with you in just a moment. Daughter, your faith had made you whole—let's go, Jairus." I love that! Of course you know how the story ended, Jesus raised Jairus' daughter from the dead.

What was the seed Jairus sowed? His position as a priest. They could have taken "his papers" from him. They could have taken his housing allowance from him,



but he sowed the seed. He put his reputation, his job, and perhaps his future on the line for his miracle. That was his seed.

There's always a seed involved in great breakthroughs!

What corresponding actions are you willing to DO to ensure that your 2023 will be a year for the maximum and the highest level attainable?

To ask God for a breakthrough and be unwilling to sow a seed is more than likely going to produce nothing. Every time you talk to God about a need, He'll talk to you about a seed. Every time I have a need, I think sow a seed, because that's what God taught me, "Don't

be need minded, be seed-minded."

Remember the story about the widow in 1st Kings 17. What God asked her to do in the natural seemed foolish. She thought she only had enough for one meal for her and her son to eat and then they were going to die.

Some of you might have had the devil tell you, "This is foolish; you better hold onto what you've got. Things could get worse down the road. What if a crisis happens and you just sowed and you don't have enough to take care of the crisis?" Well, obviously, that's the devil because God would never say something like that to you. Don't listen to the devil. God has promised to "supply all your need according to His riches in glory by Christ Jesus" (Philippians 4:19).

So, if you've had thoughts like that, and it seems foolish for you to sow, let me remind you that sometimes what God asks us to do sounds foolish, but it is not. God instructed the prophet to tell her, "make me a little cake first." And she was willing to obey, and in so doing she showed the genuineness of her faith. When you don't have much and God asks you to sow some, that seems foolish. But, what you DO first matters to God.

If you wait for all the conditions to be perfect before you sow, it's not likely they'll ever be perfect.

Some of the greatest breakthroughs that Carolyn and I have experienced, not only personally, but in our ministry, have come when the conditions were not perfect. It seems like that is when God has told me to sow the

most. The Apostle Paul said in 1st Corinthians 1:27, "But God hath chosen the foolish things of the world to confound the wise..."

Prove the genuineness of your faith in this prophetic word coming to pass in your life. Sow and obey God even when it looks foolish. There is a very powerful principle in God's Word: as you GO and DO (faith with corresponding actions) is when you get maximum results. It is your supreme expression of faith.

Carolyn and I have lived this way for 54 years now and I have this testimony, **God has never ever let me down!** He is no respecter of persons, and so what He has done for us, He will do for you. And when He does, make sure you give Him the praise for it!

Many of the people who received maximum results in the Word of God were desperate for a miracle; they were willing to do what other people thought would be foolishness. They were willing to do what others weren't willing to do.

Sometimes you just have to break away from the crowd. What other people think is foolishness, you DO because you know that this is what God told *you* to do, and you believe that God *will* cause you to have an "afterwards." *You* are willing to act on your faith.

James 2:17-18 tells us, "Even so faith, if it hath not works (corresponding actions), is dead, being alone. 18 Yea, a man may say, Thou hast faith, and I have works (corresponding actions): me thy faith without thy works (corresponding actions), and I will shew thee my faith by my works (corresponding actions)." You can't have one without the other—if you want a breakthrough. The Message translation says it like this, "Faith and works (corresponding actions), works (corresponding actions) and faith, fit together hand in glove."

Never underestimate the power and the potential of a seed sown.

The ability to experience breakthroughs in your life is within the seeds that you are *willing* to sow. You may not presently have all that you need, but you *do* have the seed that will make it happen. You are never without seed. And remember, money is not the only seed.

I remember one time I bought a nice pair of slacks and a sweater, and before I ever wore them, I was believing God for a financial breakthrough. I said, "Lord, I don't have any money to sow." He said, "You're not without seed." I said, "What seed do I have?" He said, "How about that new sweater and slacks." He said "You do have seed. You're never without seed."

I hadn't even worn them yet! But that was the seed for my breakthrough. Isn't that a whole lot better than saying, "Okay, Lord, I'll go in my closet and look in the very back at that old sweater and that old pair of slacks I never did like anyway, and then I'll sow that!" You know what that will produce? A hundredfold of sweaters and slacks you don't like!





The sower will never be without seed.

You may not have money to sow, but you do have something. If nothing else, you can go to somebody else in need, and say, "I want to agree with you in prayer. That's all the seed I have right now." Or it could be, just walk up to somebody and say, "I know you're going through a tough time, but I want you to know, I'm standing with you." That may be the only seed you have at the moment—just a kind word, or a prayer. It could be God tells you, "Go mow your neighbor's yard." You do have a seed.

It's been said that a seed has the potential and the power to influence every aspect of our lives—spiritually, physically, financially, and socially.

All will be governed by the seeds that you have sown. I learned this principle many years ago, seed time and harvest were ordained by God as a means of insuring that you

and I will continually experience increase in our lives. Jesus said the kingdom of God is like unto a seed. The kingdom of God is based on seeds. You can't find miracles in the Bible where there is not a seed involved.

Are you ready to add some corresponding actions to your confession of faith that this year will be a year for the maximum and the highest level attainable?

Are you willing to show the genuineness of your faith with your corresponding actions? If so, then get ready to GO and DO by sowing your significant seeds! God is faithful and He will see to it that your breakthrough will come!
