DECIDE DECREE DISPERSE

JERRY SAVELLE

The Lord saw the prophetic word about our 2024 being a year of progression, advancement, promotion and our highest expectations being fulfilled.

Have you made a decision to join us? Are you *expecting* it? There's a difference between wanting something and actually expecting it.

Do you believe it? To "believe" is to have a firm persuasion, to have certainty, to have complete confidence in something coming to pass. Jesus said in Matthew 8:13, "...as thou hast believed, so be it done unto thee."

The Apostle Peter, by the inspiration of the Holy Spirit, tells

the people that he has been writing to (*believers*) that it's important that we continue to be stirred up about the truths that we've already heard and learned.


> "Wherefore I will not be negligent to put you always in remembrance of these things, though ye know them, and be established in the present truth. ... as long as I am in this tabernacle, to stir you up by putting you in remembrance ..." (2 Peter 1:12-13).

Peter was saying it is important to never forget the basics, to stay in remembrance of them, and that for as long as he was here in this earth, he would continue to emphasize this important part of our life of faith.

NEVER LET GO OF THE BASICS!

Builders don't destroy the foundation to start building a house, they build a house on the foundation. That's what the Word of God is designed to do, *to create a foundation that you build your life upon*.

I've been building on this foundation of faith for 55 years, basic fundamental truths about



the life of faith from my mentors Kenneth Copeland, Kenneth Hagin, Oral Roberts, and T.L. Osborn. And I couldn't get enough; I listened to their messages over and over. In fact, I still listen to them to this day.

God will always build on the basics. The Word of God is inexhaustible. This is why God impressed upon me to go over the basics again in this season so *this year can be the best year you've ever had since you've been a believer*... if you choose for it to be.

Keep growing in the Lord. Don't ever get to the place where you are satisfied with the knowledge that you already have. Enjoy what you know. Keep acting on it, but always seek the Lord for more insight.

We often stand in faith on Mark 11:24, "Therefore I say unto you,

What things soever ye desire, when you pray, believe that ye receive them. and ve shall have them."

Notice that desire alone will not produce what you are standing in faith for; when you *believe* that you will receive it is when you will have it.

Remember that our believing has to be based on what God has promised in His Word, not just something we came up with that sounds good.

Once you believe, you have to put action to your belief. This is where many believers miss it.

One of the key principles the Lord revealed to me many years ago is *The Three D's To Success*. I'm still applying it today, and this principle is still working for me. It will work for you also if you will apply it consistently to your life and don't quit standing in faith until you see your highest expectations fulfilled.

THE THREE D'S TO SUCCESS: 1. DECIDE

3. **DISPERSE** We all know that life is full of choices, right? Our entire existence is based on choices. You're making

choices every moment of the day.

Choices have consequences, good or bad. We have all made bad choices, and I believe we can all

agree that right choices are much better for our lives.

In Deuteronomy 30:19, God said the decision to choose life is in our hands. "I call heaven and earth to record this day against you, that I have set before you life and death, blessing and cursing, therefore choose life, that both thou and thy seed may live."

It is a life or death decision according to the Word of God, so we must choose, or let me say it this way *decide*, wisely.

DECIDE

Notice, it's our choice. *You mean I can choose to be blessed?* Yes! You can choose life or death. You can choose blessings or curses. God gives you the right to make the choice. But you have to DECIDE.

I choose to be blessed and not cursed. I decided that my 2024 will be exactly what God said. You also have to choose whether your 2024 is going to be a year of progression, advancement, and promotion. What will you choose?

In Joshua 24:15, Joshua told God's people "...*choose you this day whom ye will serve*..."

In other words, if you want to serve other gods, then go for it. If you choose the Lord your God, then do so, but make a *decision*. Make a *commitment*.

It sounds like an easy decision, right? Why would anyone want to choose death and the curse? The problem oftentimes is that people want to switch back and forth, but God has made it clear we have to *decide*.

GOD WANTS ALL OF YOU!


God doesn't want you living one foot in the world and one foot in the kingdom. God will not accept a divided heart. He wants you all the way. You have to *decide* who you will belong to, who you will serve.

Why? You can't have it both ways. Either you belong to God, or you don't. You will obey the one you serve. You have to decide to serve God.

God and His Word are a package deal. His Word is His will. If you choose God, you are also choosing His Word. I would call choosing God a right choice, and right choices have benefits (positive consequences). In fact, God said that right choices are *life*.

On the other hand, if you reject His Word, it will not go well for you. In Proverbs 1:29-33, they rejected knowledge. They turned their backs on God and His counsel (Word). This was their consequence, "You've made your own bed, now lie in it. You wanted your own way – now how do you like it?" (MSG).

"How do you like it now" is a good question. Carelessness



kills, and complacency is murder. Wrong choices have negative consequences. Very serious consequences that God wants to spare you from. God called this way *death*.

Being in the perfect will of God is a result of making the right choices. I want to stay in the perfect will of God. There are many benefits to choosing to receive God's counsel (His Word).

You can seek God and His kingdom, or you can refuse to. He promises that if you seek first Him and His kingdom (His way of doing and being right), then "all these things shall be added unto you" (Matthew 6:33).

NECESSITIES WILL BE ADDED

The material necessities of life will be added to your life. I'm

believing! And I'm asking you to join with me this year. Psalm 65:11 decrees, "Thou crownest the year with Thy goodness; and Thy paths drop fatness."

I'm believing that our 2024 will be crowned with God's goodness. It will be a year that we are surrounded by His favor, a year in which His blessings are continually manifesting in our behalf; and a year in which we experience God's progression, advancement, promotion, and the fulfillment of our highest expectations.

God is a progressive God. He never regresses. He's always increasing, going toward bigger and better. And He has sent His Word to help us progress with Him.

If the people in the Bible were given choices, then so have we! You have to make your choice about 2024 certain. Are you going to remain as you are? Or are you going to progress? Notice, the first thing you have to do is decide if you agree with and therefore are entitled to what God says. We have a covenant with God as born-again believers.

So the first question is: Are you born again? If not, you can fix that right now by praying the prayer of faith unto Salvation (Romans 10:9, 1 John 4:15). We enter into a covenant with God by confessing or decreeing according to Scripture.

You have to make the Word of God the final authority in your life. You have to decide that everything God said He will do in your life.

Once you are in covenant with God, then you have a right to every promise He has made us. This is the importance of saying what we believe. This brings us to the second "**D**."

DECREE

With what I have shared with you from God's Word, I have made it perfectly clear that God wants your 2024 to be a successful year.

Now, it's time for you to decide that this is the way that it's going to be in your life. Once you decide that what God said is yours, then according to Job 22:28 "*Thou shalt also decree a thing and it shall be established unto thee and the light shall shine upon thy ways.*"

The Amplified Bible says it this way, "And the light [of God's favor] will shine upon your ways." Decide that that's the way it's going to be in your life and then decree it!

Notice first you must decide, and then you *decree*. Decision comes first before the talking (before the decreeing and confessing). Next, you must begin decreeing it.

The Apostle Paul said in 2 Corinthians 4:13, "...I believed and therefore have I spoken..." That's what decreeing is: speaking what God says.

You cannot be quiet about what you believe. Thinking it is not enough, you have to say what you believe. The Passion Translation says it this way, *"First I believed, then I spoke in faith."* We know this worked for Paul and we know it worked for Jesus. In fact, we know it worked for God. God brought the Word to the earth by believing and decreeing it in faith, and then He gave us His way for increase: The law of seedtime and harvest. He told us to sow (disperse) seed and it would be to us provision.

DISPERSE

The third "**D**" is **DISPERSE**. To *disperse, distribute*, or *sow*, as we most often think of it, is the Bible's way to acquire what you desire.

Throughout scripture our money is described as *seed*. Even a small seed sown in fertile soil is capable of producing immeasurable results (Matthew 13:8).

Many years ago, I was interviewed on a global television program, and the host asked me, "What is the greatest spiritual law that you've ever learned?" I didn't hesitate – I said immediately, "The Law of Sowing and Reaping!" (See Genesis 1:28-29).

This is the law that Carolyn and I have lived by for the last 55 years, and it's why we are very blessed today.

We sowed our way out of lack, and we sowed our way into abundance. It's a lifestyle with us and not something we *try* occasionally. We look for opportunities to sow every day.

Every year when I receive the prophetic word for the new year, I immediately sow (DISPERSE) toward the fulfillment of it. Once I've done this, then the devil can never get me to back off of my expectancy in God bringing it to pass. I'm applying **THE THREE D'S FOR SUCCESS** that I am sharing with you today.

I want to encourage you to do the same as well.

DECIDE DECREE DISPERSE

That's God's winning combination that will cause your 2024 to be a very, very successful year. *Amen*.

When Jerry asked me to write an article for the magazine on the subject of the prophetic word for the year, I could think of nothing more fitting than the rapture of the church.

Jesus' ministry in the earth was all about the kingdom of God, and making sure we are in His kingdom now and for eternity.

This is why we must stay in the Word of God. It keeps us progressing and advancing the kingdom of God. It keeps us promoting the kingdom of God and it keeps our faith aligned with the highest expectations in the kingdom of God – His.

The highest level of each of these areas is the rapture of

the church of Jesus Christ. It is THE ultimate expectation!

One of the most comforting messages Jesus ever taught His disciples was when He told them about the rapture in advance of His departure. He promised they would one day be caught away with Him for eternity.

He was not leaving them. He was going to make their place ready. He prayed in John 17:24 that those God gave Him would be where He is after He returns to the Father.

In Paul's first letter to the Corinthians, he connects the resurrection of Jesus Christ with the future resurrection of Christians (the rapture): Behold, I tell you a mystery: we shall not all sleep, but we shall all be changed... In a moment, in the twinkling of an eye, at the last trumpet.

...But thanks be to God, who gives us the victory through our Lord Jesus Christ! 1 Corinthians 15:51-57

God is expecting a great harvest and so we should be also. It is more important than ever to keep our expectations in line with God's.

Jesus really loves us, and not the way man loves. He is an expression to us of God's great love for us. His love is eternal. Just think on that. Jesus wants us to be with Him where He is for eternity! In John 14, Jesus says, "Let not your heart be troubled; you believe in God, believe also in Me I go to prepare a place for you...I will come again, and receive you to Myself; and where I am, there, you may be also."

Jesus made a plan to fulfill His promise to return like He said. He is doing His part, and I am doing my part. He told us to occupy until He comes in Luke 19:13, and I am doing just that. I am actively fulfilling His plan for my life every day.

He lives in me, and He loves the world through me. I am intentional each day to love the world for Jesus, so it is only natural for me to share His passion for God's ultimate expectation, the rapture of His church.

He Is Coming Back!

We can help Him reach the world before His return, to bring in the great harvest of souls.

Jesus is coming back for us, and He has promised that He will come personally to take us to the Father regardless of our human condition – whether still alive or asleep in Jesus. 1 Thessalonians 4:13-14 gives us this assurance: But I do not want you to be ignorant, brethren, concerning those who have fallen asleep, less you sorrow as others, who have no hope. For if we believe that Jesus died and ROSE again, even so, God will bring with Him those who sleep in Jesus.

His resurrection power is enough to wake those who have gone before us for the last 2,000 plus years just as easily as those of us still alive in the earth that day!

Our physical condition does not impact His ability to raise us. Neither does the condition of the world.

The Sign Of The Times

Jesus told us what the world will look like when the time is near. He did not say the conditions will be great, in fact, Jesus promised He will come suddenly when the world is like it was in the days of Noah – when evil was pervasive.

As believers of the Scriptures, we know this day is close upon us.

I believe the condition of the earth matches His description. We see a lot of perversion in the world today as well as chaos ... but don't let that discourage or distract you.

We can't afford to be distracted by the conditions of the world. We have to stay alert! We must be strong in our faith.

We have an anointed assignment. It is our job to bring multitudes of people to heaven with us. To achieve this, we must stay focused on the promises of God.

This kingdom harvest will come exactly as Jesus promised, so we have to stir up our faith and keep believing what Jesus said.

His Word Is Sure

When Jesus makes us a promise, we can be sure it is based on God's promise. He didn't come of Himself, but of the Father that sent Him.

The reason the Word – Jesus – came was to reconcile man to God. To remove the separation that sin (death) brought between God and man.

He paid the ultimate price for the ultimate expectation. God expects His Word to produce His expected harvest.

God knows what it will look like when the set time has come. He gave Jesus the words to speak to us so we can recognize when His season to return has come.

If you're not ready for Jesus to return to the earth, get

ready. The kingdom of God is at hand. Repent.

This was the passionate message of John the Baptist to prepare mankind for the first arrival of Jesus, and it was the emphatic message of love that Jesus echoed from the Father in Matthew 4:17 when He began to preach, as did Peter in Acts 2:38 when 3,000 souls were added to the church on the day of Pentecost.

Now Is The Time To Stand

It is easy to see that we are closer today to the rapture of the church than ever before. When we see this, we should be encouraged. The prophecy of Jesus is all around us.

We are in a new season of kingdom progression, kingdom advancement, kingdom promotion, and the realization of God's ultimate expectation.

The message of the rapture is urgent for you and me today! We must be doing all that we can to advance the kingdom of God and the message of God's delivering power through His Word.

It is more important than ever to seek God and His knowledge. Colossians 4:2 instructs us to be devoted to those things that will keep us ready: alert prayer and an attitude of thanksgiving. This is the lifestyle that Jesus modeled for us so we can be fruitful.

God's greatest desire for

believers is to bear much fruit in these last days as we approach the resurrection of the church.

I would truly say this is the ultimate in progressing, advancing, experiencing promotion, and in seeing our highest expectations fulfilled.

The ultimate expectation for believers is the rapture of the church.

"Therefore, my beloved, brethren, be steadfast, immovable, always abounding in the work of the Lord, knowing that your labor is not in vain in the Lord," 1 Corinthians 15:58.

Why Successful People Spend Time Alone

f you were to meet me about 20 years ago, you would be amazed at how different I am and how different my life is. I was a Christian and loved God, but to put it plainly, my life was a mess—emotionally, mentally, financially.

I was full of shame, confusion, and insecurity from being in wrong relationships and making poor choices. I was just existing day after day with no real vision until everything fell apart. My husband, Rodney, and I were fighting so much and miserable. It finally got to be too much, and with a five-yearold little red-headed girl to care for, we separated.

I was working for my dad at the time, and he told me something that I did not want to hear. He said, "I want you to temporarily work from home. Alone." The idea of being alone seemed like torture to me. Little did I know that would be the very thing God used to turn my life around and get me moving forward into my purpose.

When I couldn't hide behind the distraction of busyness, and was forced to be alone, I started seeking God like never before, learning, growing, healing from the inside out, and getting a new vision for my life. And I'm grateful to say God also restored my marriage.

During that transformative time alone, I stumbled upon some important principles that have continued to shape and empower me decades later. I don't want you to hit rock bottom before you start making changes that will lead you into the fullness of what God has for you. Things may not turn around in a day, but you can start today.

I found out that the average person does not spend intentional time alone—the average successful person does. And you might think, "Alone? Why do successful people spend time alone?" It's because growth, success, and transformation, in any area of life, happens in private, behind closed doors, during the unseen hours.

What you do when nobody is watching is how you find yourself, discover your purpose and dreams, and you start hearing from God, which leads to real success. It's what I like to call "the alone advantage."

There are a variety of behindthe-scenes habits that drive crazy success, but I'll share three of them that, when cultivated, can propel you towards blessings and opportunities you never thought possible.

#1. Listen Up.

In the Bible, most people got their vision out in the hills, the deserts, the wilderness, in the quiet

place of solitude. Jesus spent time alone. Paul spent time alone. Moses spent time alone. Alone is where you receive direction, clarity, answers, wisdom, and confidence.

I heard someone say there are two reasons we find it agonizing to spend time alone: either we get bored easily, or we want to avoid the reality of where our life has ended up. I was the latter. I didn't want to be honest with myself or with God about how confused I was or how disappointed I felt with where I had landed in life (because of my own choices). You might be asking, "But what do I do when I'm alone?"

Let me point out that you will need two items that will prove to be the greatest tools on your road to success: a journal and a pen.

When was the last time you sat quietly by yourself and just thought? About what, Terri? Life. Your future. Where you are headed. Where you see yourself five years from now. What you really want. What you want to change. What's bothering you. Who you need to forgive. What you need to stop doing. What you need to pursue. What God is speaking to your heart.

Typically, whatever impression comes up in your heart is something God is dealing with you about. You may even hear only one word: Forgive. Rest. Give. Stop. Freedom. Embrace. Discipline. One word can provide more direction for your life than an entire journal of random thoughts. Perhaps, like me years ago, you haven't been still long enough to ask yourself and God those vital questions and—more importantly—to obtain answers, because you're never alone. Maybe you even pray, like I did every morning, but you never pause long enough to listen for God to communicate back to you.

Go somewhere quiet where no one can bother you and give your heavenly Father your full attention. Listen up for what God is speaking to your heart by scheduling time to be alone, to think and journal. It's the alone advantage that leads to discovering God's will for your life.

But when you pray, go into your most private room, close the door and pray to your Father who is in secret, and your Father who sees [what is done] in secret will reward you. —MATTHEW 6:6 AMP

#2. Step Up.

What if God could only bless what you were prepared for? How would that change how you spend your time? Coach John Wooden said, "When opportunity comes, it's too late to prepare."

Which opportunity do you need to start getting ready for now, behind closed doors, so you can take advantage of it when God sends it to you? Preparation time is never wasted time, so even if it seems foolish to those around you, what do you need to do to start preparing today?

I think about my dad back in 1969 when he first felt God calling him to preach. Nobody knew him. He'd never preached a sermon. He owned Jerry's Paint & Body Shop and worked on wrecked cars. But God told him to get ready, to prepare in private, so one day He could use him in public.

The Lord told him to go into his guest bedroom and pray for the people who will one day hear him preach. Then, the Lord told him to prepare his sermon for the people who will one day hear him preach. And then, the Lord said, "Put your suit on and preach as if you're preaching to the people who will one day hear you."

Keep in mind, this is all being done behind the scenes, behind closed doors, in private, just my dad and the Lord. But the day came when he was working for Kenneth Copeland, assisting him, selling his messages, driving him around, and seemingly out of nowhere, Kenneth Copeland called my dad's hotel room and said, "Are you ready? I want you to preach this morning." Dad said, "I'm ready."

What if you seized the alone advantage to get ready, to prepare for the dreams in your heart. That's what successful people do. What could happen in your life tomorrow if you started getting ready today behind closed doors? Now is the time to prepare for what you've prayed for and get ready for all God wants to do in your life.

#3. Wake up.

If you're ready to face your day with purpose, instead of just seeing what the day brings, it all starts with how you wake up. If your first action of the day is to hit the snooze button, you are training yourself to live by how you feel and to procrastinate going after what matters most to you.

Over the years, I found out that successful people have the habit of waking up earlier than others. Why? To invest in themselves. Waking up 30 minutes earlier than you currently do each day would give you an extra 15 hours a month to work on you, to prepare for your success, to hear God's voice and get His direction for the next phase of your life.

Join the most successful people in the world by winning the "battle of the bed" and start waking up a little earlier to invest in yourself. Use this valuable window of time to do things like read books, pray, journal, exercise, and learn in areas the Lord is directing you. This is a critical step in developing the self-discipline needed to move from where you are to where you want to be.

God always has more for you. He did not create you to settle at a certain level and stay there. His desire is that you continue to increase, progress, and experience greater success. I believe that you can become almost unrecognizable because of how much God changes your life... because that's exactly what happened to me.

Remember this: People are rewarded in public for what they practice in private. Changing your life happens by what you do behind closed doors, and that's what leads to success in front of the crowd. When you master your minutes in private, you will master your life in public.



When my dad first spoke the Word he received from the Lord for 2024, I immediately began to speak it over my life, but in saying it daily, the Lord showed me something...

See, some people think, "Okay, if I repeat this over and over it will happen," but they get frustrated and disappointed at the end of the year when it hasn't happened for them.

BELIEVE FIRST!

The Lord instructed me, "It's great, Jerri, to say these words every day, but there has to be FAITH in what you say and expectation in your words!"

It's not just saying it that's going to make it happen. Jesus instructs us in Mark 11:22-23, to *first* have faith in God. Secondly, you *cannot have doubt* in your heart. Thirdly, you must **believe**, and *then* you **speak** it!

When you have done all those things, then His wonderful promise to us is, "...whatever thing you ask when you pray, believe that you receive them, and **you will have them!**

Faith Sees & Faith Hears!

What does progressing, advancing, promotion, and highest expectations fulfilled look like for you?

Begin to get a clear image of it manifesting in your life. See it happening with YOUR eyes of faith.

Faith sees in the spirit what has not happened yet in the natural ... but *faith* is confident *it will happen!*

Listen with your Spirit to how The Passion Translation explains faith in the unseen in Hebrews 11:1– "Now faith brings our hopes into reality and becomes the foundation needed to acquire the things we long for. It evidence is all the required to prove what is still unseen."

You have to have faith to make this word a reality in your life! You can't just hope it happens.

Again, it can't just be words you

recite regularly and think, "Okay, I said it 25 days in a row, Lord. Make it happen!"

Hebrews 4:2 gives us an example of this. These people heard the Word preached, but it did them no good because, "they didn't join their faith with the Word. Instead, what they heard didn't affect them deeply, for they doubted" (TPT).

THE HEART-MOUTH CONNECTION

I've heard it said this way: there must be a heart and mouth connection! What you believe down on the inside *will* come out your mouth.

Get doubt out of your mouth, heart, and head right now! Doubt does not belong in the mouth, mind, or heart of a believer!

In fact, that's an oxymoron. *Doubt* and *believer* don't even go together! Either you're a believer or you're not!

I know it may *look* impossible. You may be thinking, *"How?!*"

Settle it once and for all today. *"My God can and He will."*

It's not our job to figure out how He will bring His Word to pass. Our part is to have faith, not doubt!

We must **believe** first, and then **say** that He will do it!

FOCUS ON JESUS!

When you dwell on Jesus and make *Him* the center of your attention, then not only will He provide your needs and give you the desires of your heart, Ephesians 3:20 says, that *He will do, "...far more* than you could ever imagine or guess or request in your wildest dreams!" (MSG). Wow!

- Stop looking at the circumstances!
- Don't focus on the bad report.
- Quit looking at the amount in your bank account.


Instead, keep your eyes on Jesus, the source of your faith!

Season of Promotion

Any years ago, God began using me to share His prophetic word for the year all around the world. It is vitally important that we have knowledge from God about the times and seasons we are living in.

God said in Hosea 4:6 that His people are "destroyed for a lack of knowledge." So, I have faithfully set aside time to receive the prophetic impartation from God each fall and then share it globally throughout the year to help prevent destruction in the lives of God's people, and to help people to be winners in life.

In the fall of 2023, the Lord began to reveal to me His

prophetic word for 2024. A couple of months later, I was in Canada with my evangelism team sharing this message with our partners, and while I was there, God gave me a deeper insight into 2024 that it will not only be progressing and advancing to see our highest expectations fulfilled, there's more!

I experienced several special moments with the Lord while I was there. One night, He awakened me at 2:02 a.m. and said that it will also be a season of promotion, and of many new blessings.

I am always excited to hear what He has planned for us, and so I set my expectations right then and there for it to manifest in my life and in the lives of my partners around the world.

God has been so faithful these 55 years in ministry to do exactly what He has said. Because He has already done so many wonderful things, some people may wonder what He could possibly have in store next that we haven't already experienced.

God Has More For Us!

We know from 1 Corinthians 2:9 that we have not yet seen everything that God has in store for us. We can't even imagine it! I believe the best is yet to come.



To experience what God has revealed to me about this season will require us to stay in faith, remain focused on the promises of God's Word, and refuse to allow anything to distract us.

It's A New Season!

So, exactly what does a season of promotion and new blessings look like? In Leviticus 25:8-10 it describes a season of promotion and new blessings specifically for God's people: the year of jubilee.

Every fifty years, what was lost was restored, and there was an increase in ways they had never known before. This is the kind of season the Lord revealed to me while preaching in Canada.

It is a time for promotion and new blessings like we have never seen before. He told me we must begin to declare it, expect it, and rejoice over it!

Ways To Walk Out Our Faith:

God has used His prophets throughout human history to get specific instructions to His people. He is doing the same thing now.

Isaiah said that when God speaks, we are to give Him glory through our response of praise and worship (Isaiah 42:9-12, 23).

It is vitally important that we *praise God in advance* of seeing results! We are to respond as though the result have already manifested. God never lies. What God says, He does!

We should express our agreement with what God has said by speaking in faith over it and we should expect that it will happen.

One way we can put action to our faith is to decree what God said. For example, we decree we will enter this season of promotion and new blessings, and we declare that we are going to progress and advance. We say that we will



experience promotion and see our highest expectations being fulfilled, now, in this time, not someday.

Then we must stand in faith knowing that no devil can stop God's set time. He couldn't stop Jesus' set time, and he can't stop our set time either!

As we go about our day, we should greet one another with statements of faith and encourage one another. Some examples are: "It's the year of progression!" Or we can say, "It is your season of promotion!"

You Have A Covenant With God

Stay mindful of *our covenant with God* that helps us walk out our faith and live the way God designed us to live.

As covenant people, we should be decreeing the blessings of God in Deuteronomy 28 over our lives and families. Verse 13 tells us that we are never to be on the losing side, we are always on top!


The conditions of poverty, bondage, chaos, defeat, and

destruction in the world are not ours. We are not under the curse.

God blessed us and that means we are empowered by God to prosper!

An integral part of being in covenant with God is believing what He has said and living in a way that shows we believe Him. That may sound basic, but we are to never forget the basics.

Hebrews 11:6 tells us that we must live a life of faith to please God, and that means sometimes we have to keep our faith through circumstances that try to overcome us.



Stay In Faith!

We must hold fast to our faith as the Apostle Paul instructed us in 1 Timothy 1:19, no matter how things look in this world. We must refuse to allow distractions like wars, political unrest, carnal ideologies running, or even what is in our bank account at the time, to move us.

Remember, the things we see around us in this realm are subject to change because they are subject to our FAITH!

Another way to express our faith is to be resolute (steadfast, unwavering) in our commitment

to obey and serve faithfully. We must obey God quickly, without hesitation. Or let me say it this way, without doubt.

Refuse to waver, or doubt, what God said! We saw the results of that back in the Garden of Eden and how devastating it was to their lives, and to the lives of generations after them.

It is increasingly important to stay focused. Brother Copeland emphasized to me many years ago the importance of staying what he called single-minded; focused with strict adherence to and observance of the Word of God; not allowing deviation or compromise. James 1:7 shows us that the result of wavering is to receive nothing from the Lord, so staying focused and in faith ensures we are in the right position to receive what God has said.

Keeping our *faith* and being committed in our *obedience* and faithful *service* is the only way to experience promotion from God.

That sounds like a tall order to fill, but if we do as God instructs and keep the Word of God before our eyes day and night, we can remain focused.

Keep Your Eyes On The Word

When I was first learning about faith, I would listen to tapes over and over and over. I kept the Word before my eyes and going into my ears. I spent hours daily reading my Bible.

I was hungry for the Word of God, and I have remained hungry for the Word all these years later.

What was I doing? I was hearing and hearing. I was keeping my eyes on the Word. I was developing my faith and I want to encourage you to do the same. Keep your eyes on the Word.

When you *read* the Word, take notes and write down key Scriptures. Put them on your refrigerator or bathroom mirror where you will see them daily, and use them to speak over your life and stir-up your faith.

When we *write* down the vision and keep it where we can see it, we make it part of our day.

When you *hear* what God is saying, grab it quickly with your

faith and keep hold of it no matter what the enemy does to try to get you to let go of the promises of God.

Sometimes it can be a challenge to find reliable resources, so we have made a wide variety of resources available on our website, app, and social media platforms. These resources are to help keep the Word before your eyes and to build and keep your faith strong.

The key is to keep the Word before you day and night. You will find that as you begin to meditate on Scripture and speak God's Word more often, you will see more results!

God's Word Is Order

John 1:1 shows us how important the Word is to God; "In the beginning was the Word, and the Word was with God, and the Word was God." The Word comes to us to establish God's order – bringing things into conformity with His will. In Genesis 1, the first thing God did on earth was to bring order to the chaos that was upon the face of the waters by sending His Word.

When the time had come for God to reconcile man to Himself, Jesus - who is the Word of God - became flesh and lived among the people on the earth (John 1:14 KJV). Jesus (the Word of God) restored the order between God and man.

The Word of God will do the same thing for our lives now, but we have to believe what He said and make it our foundation, our truth. The definition of truth is the highest form of reality that exists. What is true to God is the highest truth, therefore, the Bible is the highest form of reality that exists.

When the Word of God becomes our truth, our highest form of reality, and we continue trusting God without wavering, promotion will always come.

It Is Our Time

You may ask how we can know that this is our time for promotion from God?

Ecclesiastes 3:1 reveals that it is God's way for everything to have



a time and season. He has set the order of when all things happen. He sets the times and seasons.

When God says it is time for a new thing, such as the case is now, then we have to hear that Word and embrace it. We have to act on it, believing it is our highest form of reality, despite what is in our environment.

When we truly expect what God said to come to pass, it will change our behavior. We will let go of the past and make room for the new. We will experience our season of promotion with new blessings like in the year of jubilee in Leviticus 25.

Our jubilee has come and it's time for life to look like what God said about them. We will live lives free from bondage and experience restoration. We will experience promotion and our highest expectations being fulfilled.

God is faithful, and He will do His part, but it is not just going to happen automatically. We have to do our part. Folks, let me encourage you again to follow the instructions that God has given us for this year:

 Stay in Faith.
 Remain
 Focused on the promises of God.
 Refuse to be distracted by what's happening in the world.

Never forget that God watches how we react and how we respond to what is happening around us. Our response is to always be obedient to His Word and stay in faith.

I have used these principles for 55 years, and I can testify that they work. If you'll do these things then you will enjoy this season of promotion that God has in store for 2024!

Declare:

In 2024, I will enter into my season of promotion! I will enter into a new season of blessings!

- This is my new season of progression, advancement, promotion, and my highest expectations being fulfilled!
- In my season, the blessing will include freedom from all bondage and family members reunited.
- No devil can stop God's set time. He couldn't stop Jesus' set time, and he can't stop my set time!
- I will keep the Word of God before my eyes. I will meditate on the Word day and night, and therefore I will keep hold of my faith.
- I will get my expectations from God, and I will see them fulfilled!
